The Board of Land & Natural Resources approved the award of the construction contract for the subject project on July 8, 2011. Pursuant to Chapter 343, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS), and Chapter 11-200, Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR), the attached Exemption Notification labeled Exhibit A was prepared.


The project consists of installing of a new fully implemented Photovoltaic (PV) system on the roof of the existing comfort station.

In accordance with Hawaii Administrative Rule Section 11-200-8(A) and the Exemption List for the Department of Land and Natural Resources, Division of State Parks, as reviewed and concurred upon by the Environmental Council on December 4, 1991, the subject project is exempt from the preparation of an environmental assessment pursuant to Exemption Class No. 3, Item No. 2 that states "Construction of park comfort stations with accommodations of 10 or less toilets and urinals [February 5, 1976].

RECOMMENDATION:

Declare that, after considering the potential effects of the proposed project as provided by Chapter 343, HRS, and Chapter 11-200, HAR, these projects will probably have minimal or no significant effect on the environment and is therefore exempt from the preparation of an environmental assessment.

Consulted Parties:	Citizen's Advisory Committee (CAC) for Diamond Head State Monument.
Exemption Class & Description:	Environmental Council, December 4, 1991, Exemption Class No. 3, construction and location of a single, new, small facilities or structures and the alteration and modification of same including but not limited to: (A) Single family residences not in conjunctions with the building of two or more such units; (B) Multi-Unit structures designed for not more than four dwelling units if not in conjunction with the building of two or more such structures; (C) Stores, office, and restaurants, designed for total occupant load of twenty persons or less, if not in conjunction with the building of two or more such structures; and (D) Water, sewage, electrical, gas, telephone, and other essential public utility services extensions to serve such structure or facilities; and accessory or appurtenant structures including garages, carports, patios, swimming pools, and fences [HAR 11-200-8(a)(3)].
Exemption Item Number and Description:	Item 2 which states, "Construction of park comfort stations with accommodations of 10 or less toilets and urinals [February 5, 1976]".
Recommendation	It is anticipated this project will probably have minimal or no significant effect on the environment and is presumed to be exempt from the preparation of an environmental assessment.
