**Declare Project Exempt From Requirements of Chapter 343, HRS, and
Title 11, Chapter 200, Hawaii Administrative Rules
for
Job No. H10C620B, Kahana Valley State Park, Renovate Coconut Grove and Orientation
Building Comfort Stations, Kahana, Oahu, Hawaii**

The Board of Land & Natural Resources approved the award of the construction contract for the subject project on July 12, 2013. Pursuant to Chapter 343, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS), and Chapter 11-200, Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR), the attached Exemption Notification labeled Exhibit A was prepared.

The project consists of renovating existing restrooms, including, but not limited to, concrete masonry walls, concrete slab floor, metal gates, toilet partitions, toilet accessories, painting, mechanical, electrical, site work, roofing, and miscellaneous related work.

In accordance with Hawaii Administrative Rule Section 11-200-8(a)(1), and the Exemption List for the Department of Land and Natural Resources, Division of State Parks, as reviewed and concurred upon by the Environmental Council on December 4, 1991, the subject project is exempt from the preparation of an environmental assessment pursuant to Exemption Class No. 1, that states, "Operation, repairs, or maintenance of existing structures, facilities, equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion or change of use beyond that previously existing."

RECOMMENDATION

Declare that, after considering the potential effects of the proposed project as provided by Chapter 343, HRS, and Chapter 11-200, HAR, this project will probably have minimal or no significant effect on the environment and is therefore exempt from the preparation of an environmental assessment.

Exemption Item Number and Description:	Exemption Item No. 3 of Class No. 1 states: "Cabins, pavilions picnic and trail shelters, utility buildings and shed – within developed, maintained portions of State Parks."
