**Declare Project Exempt From Requirements of Chapter 343, HRS, and Title 11,  
Chapter 200, Hawaii Administrative Rules**

**Job No. F55C642C - Waianapanapa State Park Sewer System Improvements and  
Job No. F55B642B - Waianapanapa State Park Rental Cabin Repairs – Phase 2  
Hana, Maui, Hawaii**

The Board of Land & Natural Resources approved the award of the construction contract for the subject project on July 12, 2013. Pursuant to Chapter 343, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS), and Chapter 11-200, Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR), the attached Exemption Notifications labeled Exhibit A and Exhibit B were prepared.


The sewer project consists of the replacement of 6 existing cesspools that services the 12 cabins at the park with individual wastewater systems including appurtenances; and the cabin repair project consists of renovating all 12 cabins including but not limited to hazardous materials abatement, concrete, carpentry, sheet metal, doors, windows, flooring, painting, furniture, appliances, toilet and bath accessories, tent fumigation, plumbing, electrical and other related work.

In accordance with Hawaii Administrative Rule Section 11-200-8(A) and the Exemption List for the Department of Land and Natural Resources, Division of State Parks, as reviewed and concurred upon by the Environmental Council on December 4, 1991, the sewer project is exempt from the preparation of an environmental assessment pursuant to Exemption Class No. 3, Item No. 7 that states, "Construction of park water and underground utilities [February 5, 1976]". The cabin repair project is exempt pursuant to Exemption Class 1, Item No. 3, that states, "Cabins, pavilions, picnic and trail shelters, utility buildings and shed – within developed, maintained portions of State Parks [February 5, 1976]."

**RECOMMENDATION**

Declare that, after considering the potential effects of the proposed project as provided by Chapter 343, HRS, and Chapter 11-200, HAR, these projects will probably have minimal or no significant effect on the environment and is therefore exempt from the preparation of an environmental assessment.

Chapter 343 Trigger(s)	Use of State Funds
Exemption Class & Description:	<u>Exemption Class No. 3</u> of the Department of Land and Natural Resources, Division of State Parks, as reviewed and concurred upon by the Environmental Council on December 4, 1991.  Construction and location of single, new, small facilities or structures and the alteration and modification of same and installation of new, small, equipment and facilities and the alteration and modification of same including but not limited to:  (A) Single family residences not in conjunctions with the building of two or more such units; (B) Multi-unit structures designed for not more than four dwelling units if not in conjunction with the building of two or more such structures; (C) Stores, offices and restaurants, designed for total occupant load of twenty persons or less, if not in conjunction with the building of two or more such structures; and (D) Water, sewage, electrical, gas, telephone, and other essential public utility services extensions to serve such structure or facilities; and accessory or appurtenant structures including garages, carports, patios, swimming pools, and fences [HAR 11-200-8(a)(3)].
Exemption Item Number and Description:	<u>Exemption Item No. 7 of Class No. 3</u> - Construction of park water and underground utility systems (waterlines limited to 2-1/2" I.D.) [February 5, 1976].
Recommendation:	It is anticipated this project will probably have minimal or no significant effect on the environment and is presumed to be exempt from the preparation of an environmental assessment
