# **REMARKS**:

Staff is requesting the approval for a right-of-entry permit to Trade-Winds Management Group, Ltd. for a team building event (Beach Volleyball) scheduled for April 28, 29, and 30, 2015 and May 1, and 2, 2015, for a total of five days. Set-up will begin daily at 7:30am and break down / final clean up by 5:30pm. Staff brings this request to the Board pursuant to the policy adopted at its meeting of June 14, 2013, Item D-11, as amended.

The proposed activity is of a similar type and scope of beach activities that periodically occurred and continues to occur on this and other beach areas across the State. Such activities have resulted in no known significant impacts, whether immediate or cumulative, to the natural, environmental and/or cultural resources in the area. As such staff believes that the proposed event/use would involve negligible or no expansion or change in use of the subject area beyond that previously existing.

Applicant has not had a lease, permit, easement or other disposition of State lands terminated within the past five years due to non-compliance with such terms and conditions.

No comments were solicited from government or community agencies.

# **RECOMMENDATION**: That the Board

- 1. Declare that, after considering the potential effects of the proposed disposition as provided by Chapter 343, HRS, and Chapter 11-200, HAR, this activity will probably have minimal or no significant effect on the environment and is therefore exempt from the preparation of an environmental assessment.
- 2. Authorize the issuance of a right-of-entry permit to Trade-Winds Management Group, Ltd., covering the subject area for team building (Beach Volleyball) purposes under the terms and conditions cited above, which are by this reference incorporated herein and further subject to the following:
  - A. The standard terms and conditions of the most current right-of-entry permit, as may be amended from time to time;
  - B. Such other terms and conditions as may be prescribed by the Chairperson to best serve the interests of the State.
