Maui Interscholastic League (MIL), a domestic non-profit corporation

LEGAL REFERENCE:

Sections 171-55, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as amended.

LOCATION:

Portion of Government lands of Haneoo situated at Hana, Maui identified by Tax Map Key: (2) 1-4-007: Portion of 009, as shown on the attached map labeled Exhibit A.

AREA:

300 sq. ft., more or less.

CURRENT USE STATUS:

The area of requested use on parcel 009 is currently unencumbered.

CHARACTER OF USE:

Maui Interscholastic League, high school surf competition purposes.

TERM OF RIGHT-OF-ENTRY:

One day event scheduled for April 9, 2016, from 7:00am to 5:00pm.

CONSIDERATION:

Staff is requesting that consideration be gratis for this event.

CHAPTER 343 - ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

In accordance with the Division of Land Management's Environmental Impact Statement Exemption List, approved by the Environmental Council and dated June 5, 2015, the subject request is exempt from the preparation of an environmental assessment pursuant to Exemption Class No. 1, that states " Operations, repairs or maintenance of existing structures, facilities, equipment or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion or change of use beyond that previously existing." Condition No. 51, that states: "Permits, licenses, registrations, and rights-of-entry issued by the Department that are routine in nature, involving negligible impacts beyond that previously existing."

APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS:

Applicant shall be required to:

- 1) Provide traffic control to assure that Haneoo Road remains clear and traffic through the area is unobstructed.
- 2) Contact the Hana Police Department to inform them of the date and time of the scheduled event along with a traffic control plan.
- 3) Obtain approval and all required permits for this event from the Department

of Land and Natural Resources, Division of Boating and Ocean Recreation.

REMARKS:

Event Coordinator Mr. Kim Ball of the Maui Interscholastic League has requested the use of 300 square feet of unencumbered land at Koki Beach, Hana, for an M.I.L surf event for the 2016 high school season. This event will host participants from most of the high schools throughout Maui County.

A total of three 10'x10' pop up tents will be erected within the requested area of use and utilized for judging and staging purposes during the competition.

No agency comments were solicited for this one day event.

RECOMMENDATION: That the Board

1. Declare that, after considering the potential effects of the proposed disposition as provided by Chapter 343, HRS, and Chapter 11-200, HAR, this project will probably have minimal or no significant effect on the environment and is therefore exempt from the preparation of an environmental assessment.
2. Authorize the issuance of a right-of-entry permit to Kim Ball of the M.I.L. covering the subject area under the terms and conditions cited above, which are by this reference incorporated herein and further subject to the following:
 - A. The standard terms and conditions of the most current right-of-entry permit form, as may be amended from time to time;
 - B. Such other terms and conditions as may be prescribed by the Chairperson to best serve the interests of the State.

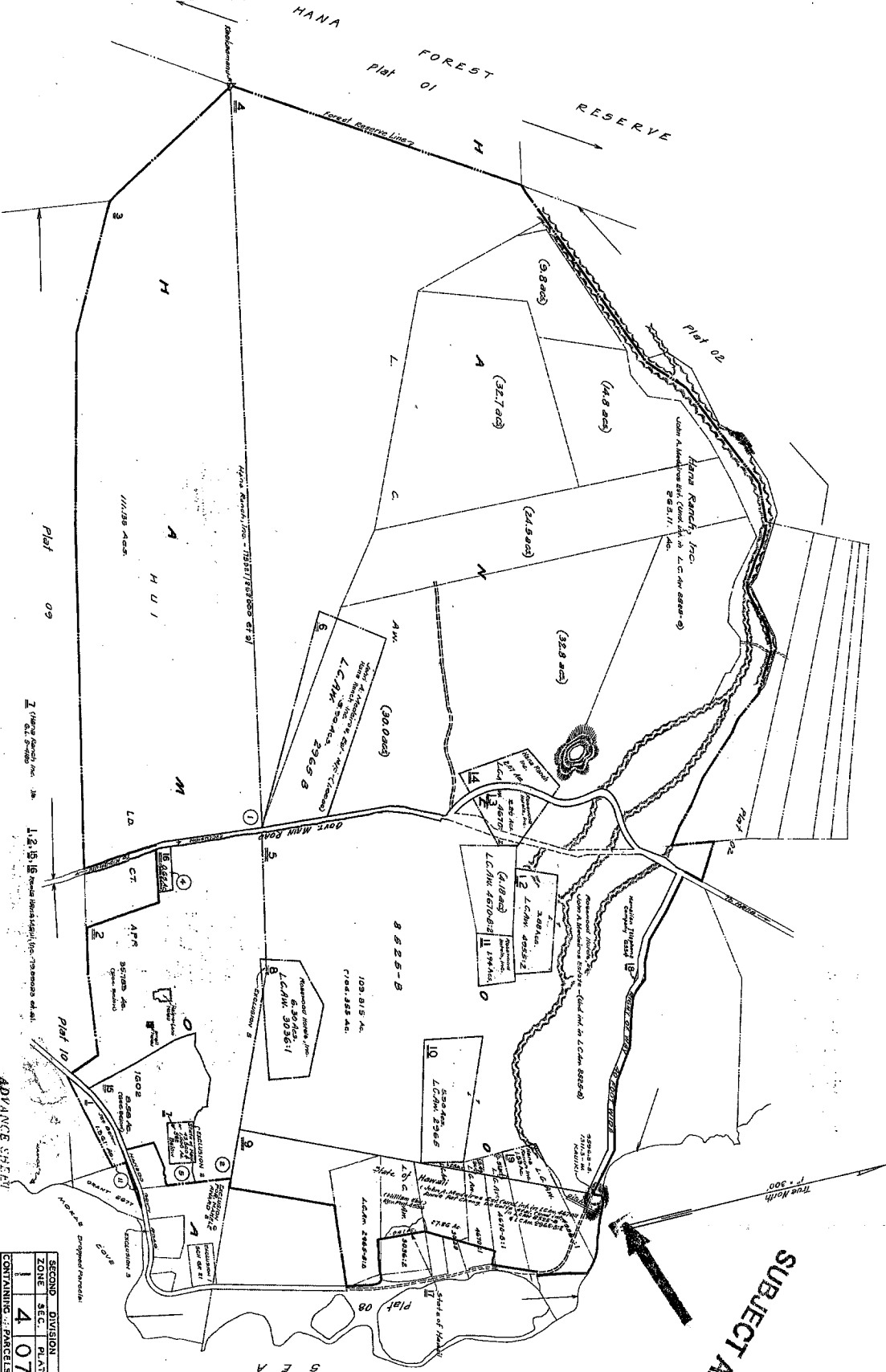


