The Board of Land & Natural Resources approved the award of the construction contract for the subject project on July 1, 2015. Pursuant to Chapter 343, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS), and Chapter 11-200, Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR), the attached Exemption Notification labeled Exhibit A was prepared.


The project consists of the reroofing of the Banquet Hall building, along with associated structural repairs to the wood roof framing members, resurfacing the existing service road, building a gravel turning area, replacing and installing posts with chain barrier.

In accordance with Hawaii Administrative Rule Section 11-200-8(A) and Approved Exemption List for the Department of Land and Natural Resources, dated June 5, 2015, the subject project is exempt from the preparation of an environmental assessment pursuant to Exemption Class 1, that states, "Operations, repairs or maintenance of existing structures, facilities, equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion or change of use beyond that previously existing."

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Declare that, after considering the potential effects of the proposed project as provided by Chapter 343, HRS, and Chapter 11-200, HAR, this project will probably have minimal or no significant effect on the environment and is therefore exempt from the preparation of an environmental assessment.


