**ADMINISTRATIVELY ESTABLISHED ACCOUNTS AND FUNDS  
OF THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES**

Section 37-52.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, requires expending departments or agencies to submit a report to the Legislature of newly administratively established accounts or funds.

The report shall include:

- (1) The justification for the establishment of the account or fund, and
- (2) The sources of revenue for the fund.

In Fiscal Year 2009, one federal account was administratively established by the Department of Land and Natural Resources.
