

OPINION NO. 3

A member of the state legislature, who is a part-time employee of a county department and who owns, with his wife, 50 shares of stock in a local corporation, asks if these interests place him in violation of Act 263, SLH 1967.

The facts supplied to the Commission indicate no violation of the standards of conduct of the Act. Section 8, the "conflicting interests" prohibition does not apply to legislators. And there is no section of the Act prohibiting legislators from ownership of stock or from engaging in other employment, per se.

This opinion is based solely on the facts presented to the Commission by the legislator as enumerated above and does not govern any situation or action not revealed to the Commission.
