ORDER DENYING JIM MEDEIROS, SR.'S, UNTIMELY ORAL REQUEST TO INTERVENE ON BEHALF OF HIMSELF AND PROTECT KEOPUKA `OHANA

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ORDER DENYING JIM MEDEIROS, SR.'S, UNTIMELY ORAL REQUEST TO INTERVENE ON BEHALF OF HIMSELF AND PROTECT KEOPUKA 'OHANA

On July 8, 2004, the Land Use Commission ("Commission") met in South Kohala, Hawai'i, to consider the Petition For Land Use District Boundary Amendment ("Petition") filed by Kamehameha Investment Corporation, a Hawai'i corporation ("Petitioner"), in the above-entitled docket. At the meeting, Jim Medeiros, Sr., vice-president of Protect Keopuka 'Ohana, orally requested to intervene in the proceedings on behalf of himself and Protect Keopuka 'Ohana based on concerns regarding, among

other things, burials and cultural resources within the Petition Area. The request was untimely and was not accompanied by the \$50 filing fee.

Present at the meeting were R. Ben Tsukazaki, Esq., on behalf of Petitioner; Bobby Jean Leithead-Todd, Esq., and Norman Hayashi on behalf of the County of Hawai'i Planning Department ("Planning Department"); and John W. K. Chang, Esq., and Abe Mitsuda on behalf of the State Office of Planning ("OP"). Petitioner objected to the oral request to intervene on the bases that it was untimely and did not comply with the provisions in section 15-15-52, Hawai'i Administrative Rules ("HAR"), regarding intervention in district boundary amendment proceedings. The Planning Department stated that it had no position on the oral request to intervene. The OP stated that it had no objections to the oral request to intervene if good cause could be shown and if this Commission allowed such intervention in the proceeding.

The Commission questioned Mr. Medeiros on, among other things, (1) whether there was excusable neglect for the untimeliness of his oral request to intervene; (2) the nature and extent of his and his organization's interest in the Petition; and (3) whether the admission of him and his organization as parties would render the proceedings inefficient and unmanageable.

Following discussion, a motion was made and seconded to deny Jim Medeiros, Sr.'s, oral request to intervene on behalf of himself and Protect Keopuka

Ohana on the grounds that said request was untimely and there was insufficient basis to establish good cause for the untimeliness. There being a vote tally of 5 ayes, 3 nays, and 1 absent, the motion carried.

ORDER

This Commission, having duly considered Jim Medeiros, Sr.'s, untimely oral request to intervene, the arguments of the parties, the record in this docket, and a motion having been made at its meeting on July 8, 2004, in South Kohala, Hawai'i, and the motion having received the affirmative votes required by section 15-15-13, HAR, and there being good cause for the motion,

HEREBY ORDERS that Jim Medeiros, Sr.'s, untimely oral request to intervene on behalf of himself and Protect Keopuka 'Ohana be DENIED.
