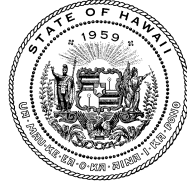

DEPARTMENT OF TAXATION ANNOUNCEMENT NO. 2012-02

RE: Act 067, Session Laws of Hawaii 2012, Relating to the Tax Lien and Encumbrance Record

On April 24, 2012, Governor Neil Abercrombie signed into law Senate Bill 2224, S.D. 1 H.D. 1 as Act 067, Session Laws of Hawaii 2012, and is effective on July 1, 2012.

Act 067 allows the Department of Taxation (Department), as well as other governmental unit, to record a lien against any vehicle owned by a taxpayer for any amounts owed. Unless the amount so recorded is paid, the taxpayer will be unable to renew, register, or transfer ownership of the vehicle. Because the amount of a tax lien may be more than a taxpayer can pay in one installment, at the request of the Department, a provision was included to allow a taxpayer to enter into an installment payment plan as an alternative to payment of the claim in full. Taxpayers who may find it necessary to enter into such a plan, however, should make arrangements with the Department well in advance of the deadline for renewal.
