DEPARTMENT OF TAXATION PUBLISHES NEW GENERAL EXCISE/USE TAX RETURN FORMS

HONOLULU—The Department of Taxation has published new General Excise/Use Tax Return Forms – the first revisions in more than twenty years – for use with tax periods beginning January 1, 2006.

Both the periodic and annual General Excise/Use Tax Return Forms have been redesigned for machine scanning and data capture. The information required is the same, only the appearance has changed. Taxpayers will still need to enter gross income, and subtract allowable deductions or exemptions from income to calculate taxable income and tax. The new forms will group activities by the rate of tax, whether wholesale, retail, or insurance commissions, and two categories of activities, sugar and pineapple are now reported by actual activity, whether producing, manufacturing, or wholesaling.

The Department of Taxation emphasizes that any taxpayer claiming allowable deductions or exemptions must attach the new Schedule GE to the periodic or annual return (Form G-45 or G-49). Schedule GE is used to explain allowable deductions or exemptions, which formerly were explained on page two of Form G-45 or G-49.

Employers will also see a new periodic Hawaii withholding return, Form HW-14. New Form HW-14 will have scanning and data capture features similar to general excise/use tax returns, and will enable faster processing of employers' withholding information.

These forms will be available beginning January 3, 2006.
