**STATE TAX RETURNS DUE FRIDAY, APRIL 20, 2007**

**Curbside drop-off available for last-minute filers on O'ahu**

HONOLULU – The Department of Taxation reminds Hawai'i taxpayers that the deadline to file State individual income tax returns is Friday, April 20, 2007.

Department of Taxation volunteers will once again be providing curbside drop-off service to last-minute taxpayers on O'ahu on April 20, from 5:00 p.m. until midnight on both the Punchbowl and Halekauwila Street sides of the Princess Ruth Keelikolani Building at 830 Punchbowl Street in Honolulu.

Another convenient and quick way to file Hawai'i tax returns is using "E-file." Taxpayers may file the Form N-11 (Hawai'i Resident Income Tax Return) or Form N-15 (Hawai'i Part-Year or Nonresident Return) through the Joint Federal/State E-filing (JELF) program. Check the Department of Taxation's website for a list of approved vendors who offer JELF at: [http://www.state.hi.us/tax/b2\\_3software.htm](http://www.state.hi.us/tax/b2_3software.htm). There is a fee involved. Form N-13 (Resident Income Return-Short Form) may be electronically filed at no cost for those receiving a refund. Go to <http://www.ehawaii.gov.org/efile/> and create an account – then file the N-13 online.

Expanded customer service telephone hours start at 7:00 a.m. and end at 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday (except State holidays), until June 29, 2007. Call (808) 587-4242 or toll free at 1-800-222-3229.
