

REVENUE TRENDS – JUNE 2005

Total tax revenue for the month of June was \$408.5 million. For FY2005, tax collections reached \$4.6 billion, an increase of \$553.2 million over that realized during the corresponding twelve-month period last year.

June 2005 general excise and use taxes totaled \$184.6 million. For the fiscal year just ended, general excise and use tax revenues have grown by 12.4%.

Transient accommodations tax (TAT) collections amounted to \$18.4 million for the month, and finished the fiscal year up by 9.3%.

For June, net individual income tax receipts were \$136.7 million, contributing to a final 18.2% growth rate for the fiscal year.

Fuel taxes were \$13.6 million, cumulatively up by 1.7% for the full 2005 fiscal year.

STATE GENERAL FUND

From June 2005 tax collections, \$373.3 million was deposited into the state general fund. For FY2005, general fund deposits were up 16.0% over FY2004.
