

REVENUE TRENDS – NOVEMBER 2005

Total tax revenue for the month of November was \$422 million. For the first five months of the 2006 fiscal year, collections are up 13.4% over the same FY2005 time period.

November 2005 general excise and use taxes totaled \$199.4 million. Fiscal year-to-date general excise and use tax revenues have grown by 13%.

Transient accommodations tax (TAT) collections amounted to \$20.5 million for the month, and are up by 7.1% for FY2006.

For November, individual income tax receipts were \$111.9 million, contributing to a 7.5% growth rate for the current fiscal year.

Fuel taxes were \$13 million, and public service company receipts added \$9.6 million to November's total.

STATE GENERAL FUND

From November 2005 tax collections, \$352.9 million was deposited into the state general fund. For the first five months of FY2006, general fund deposits are up 13.7% over the same period of FY2005.
