

REVENUE TRENDS – FEBRUARY 2006

Tax revenue for the month of February was \$412.6 million. For the first eight months of the 2006 fiscal year, collections are up 11.4% over the same period in FY2005.

General excise and use taxes totaled \$213.6 million in February, and they are up by 13.2% for the fiscal year to date.

Transient accommodations tax (TAT) collections amounted to \$21.6 million for the month, and they are up by 10.7% for the fiscal year to date.

Individual income tax receipts were \$77.5 million for the month, and they are up by 7% for the fiscal year to date.

Fuel taxes were \$14.8 million for the month, and public service company receipts were \$19.9 million.

STATE GENERAL FUND

Of the total tax collections in February, \$345.9 million was deposited into the state general fund. For the first eight months of FY2006, general fund deposits are up 11.3% over the same period in FY2005.
