

REVENUE TRENDS – OCTOBER 2006

Tax revenue for the month of October 2006 totaled \$468.9 million. Four months into the current 2007 fiscal year, collections are up 4.3% over the corresponding period last year.

General excise and use taxes totaled \$255.8 million in October, and they are up 11.6% for year-to-date FY2007.

Transient accommodations tax (TAT) collections were \$20.8 million for the month, and they are up 11.2% for year-to-date FY2007.

STATE GENERAL FUND

State general fund tax collections for the month of October 2006 totaled \$407.5 million. Four months into the current 2007 fiscal year, general fund deposits are up 4.4% over the corresponding period last year. However, adjusting for a large one-time corporation tax collection of \$40 million in September 2005, fiscal year-to-date general funds collections would have grown by 7.4% over last year.
