



### REVENUE TRENDS – NOVEMBER 2006

Tax revenue for the month of November 2006 totaled \$416.2 million. Five months into the current 2007 fiscal year, collections are up 3.1% over the corresponding period last year.

General excise and use taxes totaled \$207.0 million in November, and they are up 10.0% for year-to-date FY2007.

Transient accommodations tax (TAT) collections were \$15.5 million for the month, and they are up 3.1% for year-to-date FY2007.

### STATE GENERAL FUND

State general fund tax collections for the month of November 2006 totaled \$359.6 million. Five months into the current 2007 fiscal year, general fund deposits are up 3.8% over the corresponding period last year. However, adjusting for a large one-time corporation tax collection of \$40 million in September 2005, fiscal year-to-date general funds collections would have grown by 6.1% over last year.
