REVENUE TRENDS – SEPTEMBER 2007

Tax revenue for the month of September 2007 totaled \$425.3 million. Three months into the current 2008 fiscal year, collections are up 2.6% over the corresponding period last year.

General excise and use taxes (GET) totaled \$167.0 million in September. For the year-to-date FY2008, GET collections have increased by 6.7% over last year.

Transient accommodations tax (TAT) collections were \$14.8 million for the month, and they are up by 3.4% for year-to-date FY2008.

Individual income tax receipts were \$154 million for the month, and they are up 4.8% compared to year-to-date last fiscal year.

Corporate income tax collections were \$20.9 million in September. Fiscal year-to-date corporate income collections are up 19.8% over the same period in FY 2007.

Taxes allocated to Honolulu county surcharge collections for September 2007 totaled \$14.2 million.

STATE GENERAL FUND

State general fund tax collections for the month of September 2007 totaled \$368.0 million. Three months into the current 2008 fiscal year, general fund deposits are up 6.6% over the corresponding period last year.
