REVENUE TRENDS – NOVEMBER 2008

Tax revenue for the month of November 2008 totaled \$363.0 million. Five months into the 2009 fiscal year, tax collections are down 4.5% compared to the same period in the previous fiscal year.

General excise and use tax (GET) collections totaled \$160.0 million in November. For the year-to-date FY2009, GET collections decreased by 6.6 % compared to the same period in the previous year.

Transient accommodations tax (TAT) collections were \$15.0 million for the month. The first five months into FY2009 TAT collections are down by 8.2% compared to the same period last year.

Individual income tax collections amounted to \$108.8 million for November. For the first five months of FY2009 they are up by 3.5% compared to year-to-date last fiscal year.

Corporate income tax collections were \$1.0 million and for the first five months of FY2009 they are up by 8.7% compared to the same period last year.

Taxes allocated to Honolulu county surcharge collections for November 2008 totaled \$14.7 million.

STATE GENERAL FUND

State general fund tax collections for the month of November 2008 totaled \$308.5 million. For the first five months of fiscal year 2009, general fund deposits are down by 2.5% over the same period last year.
