

REVENUE TRENDS – MAY 2009

Tax revenues for the month of May 2009 totaled \$408.5 million. Eleven months into the 2009 fiscal year, tax collections are down 10.2% compared to the same period in the previous fiscal year.

General excise and use tax (GET) collections totaled \$151.9 million in May. For the year-to-date FY 2009, GET collections decreased by 8.4 % compared to the same period in the previous year.

Transient accommodations tax (TAT) collections were \$14.3 million for the month. For the first eleven months into FY 2009 TAT collections are down by 9.8% compared to the same period last year.

Individual income tax collections amounted to \$127.4 million for May. For the first eleven months of FY2009 they are down by 12.5% compared to year-to-date last fiscal year.

Corporate income tax collections for the year-to-date FY 2009 were down by \$31.1 million.

Taxes allocated to Honolulu county surcharge collections for May 2009 totaled \$16.6 million.

STATE GENERAL FUND

State general fund tax collections for the month of May 2009 totaled \$332.0 million. For the first eleven months of fiscal year 2009, general fund deposits are down by 9.9% over the same period last year.
