

## REVENUE TRENDS – JULY 2009

In this first month of fiscal year 2010, tax revenues totaled \$389.9 million, falling 8.9% from the corresponding month of July 2008.

General excise and use tax (GET) collections for July 2009 totaled \$200.6 million, down 8.6% compared to the previous fiscal year.

Transient accommodations tax (TAT) collections amounted to \$14.7 million in July. They fell 22.0% from the corresponding month of 2008.

Individual income tax collections were \$103.5 million for the month, down 15.0% over the corresponding period of FY 2009.

Corporate income tax collections were \$1.4 million in July and are up by \$0.8 million from last fiscal year.

Taxes allocated to Honolulu county surcharge collections amounted to \$13.7 million for the month.

## STATE GENERAL FUND

State general fund tax collections for the month of July 2009 totaled \$337.5 million. One month into the current 2010 fiscal year, general fund deposits are down 8.0% compared to the corresponding period last year.
