

REVENUE TRENDS – SEPTEMBER 2009

Tax revenue for the month of September 2009 totaled \$431.6 million. Three months into the current 2010 fiscal year, collections are down 8.5% over the corresponding period last year.

General excise and use taxes (GET) collections totaled \$183.5 million in September. For the year-to-date FY 2010, GET collections decreased by 11.8% over last year.

Transient accommodations tax (TAT) collections were \$17.5 million for the month, and they are down 11.9% for year-to-date FY 2010.

Individual income tax collections amounted to \$142.3 million for the month. The first quarter FY 2010 collections are down 6.7% compared to year to date last fiscal year.

Corporate income tax collections are down by \$4.7 million for year-to-date FY 2010.

Taxes allocated to Honolulu county surcharge collections for September 2009 totaled \$14.9 million.

STATE GENERAL FUND

State general fund tax collections for the month of September 2009 totaled \$371.0 million. For the first quarter of fiscal year 2010, general fund deposits are down 9.4% over the corresponding period last year.
