REVENUE TRENDS – OCTOBER 2009

Tax revenue for the month of October 2009 totaled \$377.7 million. Four months into the current 2010 fiscal year, collections are down 10.0% over the corresponding period last year.

General excise and use taxes (GET) collections totaled \$180.0 million in October. For the year-to-date FY 2010, GET collections decreased by 12.9% over last year.

Transient accommodations tax (TAT) collections were \$13.6 million for the month, and they are down 12.9% for year-to-date FY 2010.

Individual income tax collections amounted to \$109.9 million for the month. Four months into FY 2010, collections are down 9.6% compared to year to date last fiscal year.

Corporate income tax collections are down by \$9.4 million for year-to-date FY 2010.

Taxes allocated to Honolulu county surcharge collections for October 2009 totaled \$9.8 million.

STATE GENERAL FUND

State general fund tax collections for the month of October 2009 totaled \$324.7 million. For the first four months of fiscal year 2010, general fund deposits are down 10.9% over the corresponding period last year.
