

## **REVENUE TRENDS – NOVEMBER 2009**

Tax revenue for the month of November 2009 totaled \$418.8 million. Five months into the current 2010 fiscal year, collections are down 5.7% over the corresponding period last year.

General excise and use taxes (GET) collections totaled \$197.3 million in November. For the year-to-date FY 2010, GET collections decreased by 7.3% over last year.

Transient accommodations tax (TAT) collections were \$18.9 million for the month, and they are down 6.4% for year-to-date FY 2010.

Individual income tax collections amounted to \$101.4 million for the month. Five months into FY 2010, collections are down 9.1% compared to year to date last fiscal year.

Corporate income tax collections are down by \$9.8 million for year-to-date FY 2010.

Taxes allocated to Honolulu county surcharge collections for November 2009 totaled \$15.1 million.

## STATE GENERAL FUND

State general fund tax collections for the month of November 2009 totaled \$356.4 million. For the first five months of fiscal year 2010, general fund deposits are down 6.5% over the corresponding period last year.
