REVENUE TRENDS – DECEMBER 2009

Tax revenue for the month of December 2009 totaled \$385.4 million. Six months into the current 2010 fiscal year, collections are down 6.9% over the corresponding period last year.

General excise and use taxes (GET) collections totaled \$171.7 million in December. For the year-to-date FY 2010, GET collections decreased by 9.7% over last year.

Transient accommodations tax (TAT) collections were \$24.0 million for the month, and they are up 1.5% for year-to-date FY 2010.

Individual income tax collections amounted to \$129.4 million for the month. Six months into FY 2010, collections are down 9.3% compared to year to date last fiscal year.

Corporate income tax collections are down by \$16.8 million for year-to-date FY 2010.

Taxes allocated to Honolulu county surcharge collections for December 2009 totaled \$16.8 million.

STATE GENERAL FUND

State general fund tax collections for the month of December 2009 totaled \$321.1 million. For the first six months of fiscal year 2010, general fund deposits are down 8.2% over the corresponding period last year.
