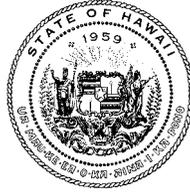

Dear Governor Abercrombie:

At its meeting on May 29, 2012, the Council on Revenues maintained its 12% forecast for State General Fund tax revenue growth in FY 2012. However, the Council lowered its growth forecast for FY 2013 from 7.5% to 5.3%. The growth rates for FYs 2014 to 2018 were unchanged.

The downward revision to the forecast for FY 2013 is mainly due to revised estimates for the revenue gains from Act 105 and the possibility that the renewable energy tax credits might cost more than initially anticipated. The Council wishes to point out that there is still considerable uncertainty about both of these estimates.

The Council considered the preliminary data reported by the Department of Taxation, which shows that cumulative General Fund collections for the first ten months of FY 2012 (July through April) were \$4,024 million.

The Council members were optimistic about the future of the economy. However, they expressed concerns about such factors as the uncertainty in European economies and the possibility of a war with Iran.

Revised forecasts of State General Fund tax revenues for FY 2012 through FY 2018 are shown in the table below. As in all multi-year forecasts, the estimates for the later years are subject to greater uncertainties.

In producing its forecasts, the Council adopted specific adjustments recommended by the Tax Department reflecting impacts on General Fund tax revenues of recent tax law changes enacted by the 2011 Legislature, including the following:

- Act 97 (SB 570 SD2 HD1 CD1). Part II repeals State tax deduction for taxpayers with Federal AGI above \$100,000 (for single taxpayers), \$200,000 (for joint filers), and \$150,000 (for heads of households). Part III caps itemized deductions at \$25,000 for a single taxpayer with Federal AGI of \$100,000 and above; \$50,000 for a joint filer with Federal AGI of \$200,000 and above; and \$37,500 for a head of household with Federal AGI of \$150,000 and above. Parts II and III sunset on January 1, 2016. Part IV delays the 10% increase in the standard deduction and the personal exemption by 2 years and makes them permanent.
- Act 103 (SB 1186 SD2 HD1 CD1) establishes a temporary \$10 minimum daily tax on each transient accommodation furnished at no charge. The Act also temporarily limits the TAT revenue distribution to the counties to \$93 million per year, and limits the distribution to the Tourism Special Fund to \$69 million per year.
- Act 104 (HB 1039 HD1 SD2 CD1) changes the Rental Motor Vehicle Surcharge Tax to \$7.50 per day from July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2012, then \$3.00 per day beginning July 1, 2012. The Act allocates the \$4.50 per day increase to the General Fund from July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2012.
- Act 105 (SB 754 SD1 HD1 CD1) suspends certain GET exemptions and imposes tax at 4 percent on the previously exempt amounts for the period from July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2013.

The Council Chair anticipated that the Department of Taxation, separately, would prepare a report for submission with this transmittal correspondence, detailing line-item forecasts for various components of the General Fund, reconciled to the Council's forecast growth rate for total General Fund Tax revenues. These line-item component

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estimates typically include, for example, General Excise Tax and Income Tax revenues that the Council on Revenues does not forecast individually. The Council Chair also anticipated that the Department of Budget and Finance would prepare a report to update its projections for non-tax and special tax revenues.

It is noted that the Department of Budget and Finance's report to the Council on Revenues for their March 2012 meeting contained inadvertent errors in the federal grants category in FYs 11-13. Since these amounts are also included in the Consolidated table, attached are the revised March 2012 Tables 1 (consolidated) and 4 (special fund from sources other than tax).

Significant Changes from March 2012 Report

General Fund Non-Tax Revenues

There are no significant changes to the general fund non-tax revenue estimates.

Special Tax Revenues

Unemployment Compensation Tax - decreases in FYs 13 and 14 reflect delays in a scheduled increase in the unemployment insurance tax for one year pursuant to Act 6, SLH 2012 (Department of Labor and Industrial Relations).

Special Fund Non-Tax Revenues

Federal Grants - the increases in FYs 11-18 reflect projected increases in Medicare payments for the Hawaii Health Systems Corporation (HHSC) based on an audit of FY 11 actual revenue collections.

Revenues from Other Agencies - the changes in FYs 12 and 13 reflect revisions to the University of Hawaii's (UH) Kapolei land sale strategy.

Charges for Current Services, Other - the increases in FYs 11-18 reflect projected increases in Medicaid and Hawaii Medical Service Association payments for HHSC based on an audit of FY 11 actual revenue collections.

Other than Special Fund Non-Tax Revenues

Federal Grants - the net increases in FYs 11-18 reflect increases in federal funds for student financial aid, information technology projects (UH) and the medical assistance program (Department of Human Services (DHS)).

Charges for Current Services - the net decreases in FYs 11-18 reflect decreases in revenue collections for drug rebates, premium shares, third party liabilities, and estates and probates in the Health Care Payments program (DHS).

Non-Revenue Receipts - the decrease in FY 12 and increase in FY 13 is attributed to a delay in the project bond issuances for several projects under development for affordable rental housing (Hawaii Housing Finance and Development Corporation).
