


# **Report to the Legislature on the Made in Hawaii Workforce Development Program Appropriation**



Prepared in accordance with Section 8 of Act 250, Session Laws of Hawaii 2025

**January 2026**

**Department of Business, Economic Development & Tourism**



The department prepared this report pursuant to Section 8 of Act 250, Session Laws of Hawaii 2025 which states that "Provided that of the general fund appropriation for strategic marketing and support (BED100), the sum of \$865,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2026-2027 shall be expended for the made in Hawaii workforce development program in accordance with section 486-119, Hawaii Revised Statutes; provided further that the department of business, economic development, and tourism shall submit a report to the legislature no later than thirty days prior to the convening of the regular session of 2026, that shall include but not be limited to the number of new companies assisted at local events and shows, number of new to export companies for both domestic and international exports, number of market expansion companies that expanding into a new region or country market, aggregate actual sales of companies assisted at consumer shows or at local, domestic, and international trade shows, aggregate projected sales anticipated within twelve to eighteen months after an export activity, aggregate number of jobs generated or supported as a result of assistance, and economic impact from assistance provided...".

## **Workforce Development Program Update**

To date, the Department of Budget and Finance has not released the \$865,000 allocated to DBEDT for the workforce development program; therefore, these funds have not been utilized. The results below reflect expenditures from BDSD's base budget and federal funding:

## Summary

Despite the delay in releasing the workforce development funds, BDSD achieved significant results using its base budget and federal funding. The program supported **126 companies** (new and expanding exporters), generated **\$1.26 million in actual export sales**, and projected **\$16.39 million in future export sales**. Local shows contributed an additional **\$458,000 in revenue**, resulting in a combined economic impact of over **\$18 million**. Output is calculated at **\$37 million**, earnings at **\$10 million**, State taxes generated totals **\$1.7 million** and jobs created or supported amounts to **235**.
