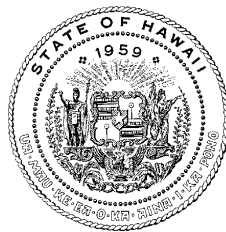

INTRODUCTION

About This Report

The report, *2000 Census Tract Names and 1990 and 2000 Resident Population for the State of Hawaii*, was produced by the Hawaii State Data Center, Research and Economic Analysis Division, Department of Business, Economic Development & Tourism with the cooperation of the City and County of Honolulu Planning and Permitting Department, County of Hawaii Planning Department and Department of Research and Development, the County of Maui Planning Department, the County of Kauai Planning Department and the L.A. Regional Census Center's Geography Department. The 2000 census tract maps included in this report were prepared by the Office of Planning in the Department of Business, Economic Development & Tourism.

Table 1 contains the 1990 census tract numbers, the 2000 census tract names and tract numbers as well as a comparison of the resident population in 1990 and 2000. Table 2 and Table 3 identifies census tracts which have changed between 1990 and 2000 along with a description of the changes. Table 4 has the number of census tracts for 1990 and 2000 by island and the last portion of the report contains the 2000 census tract maps for the State of Hawaii.

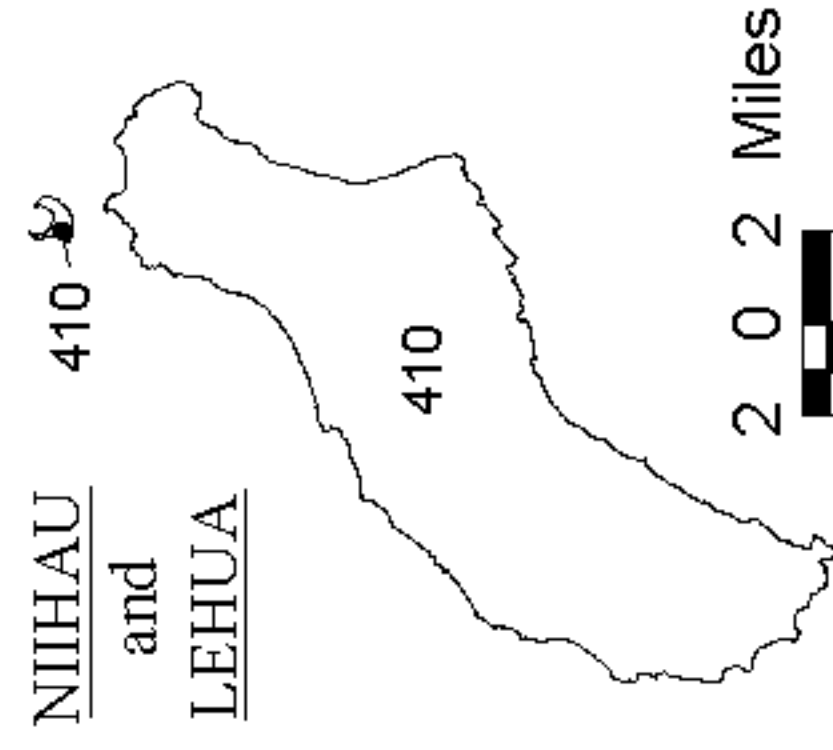
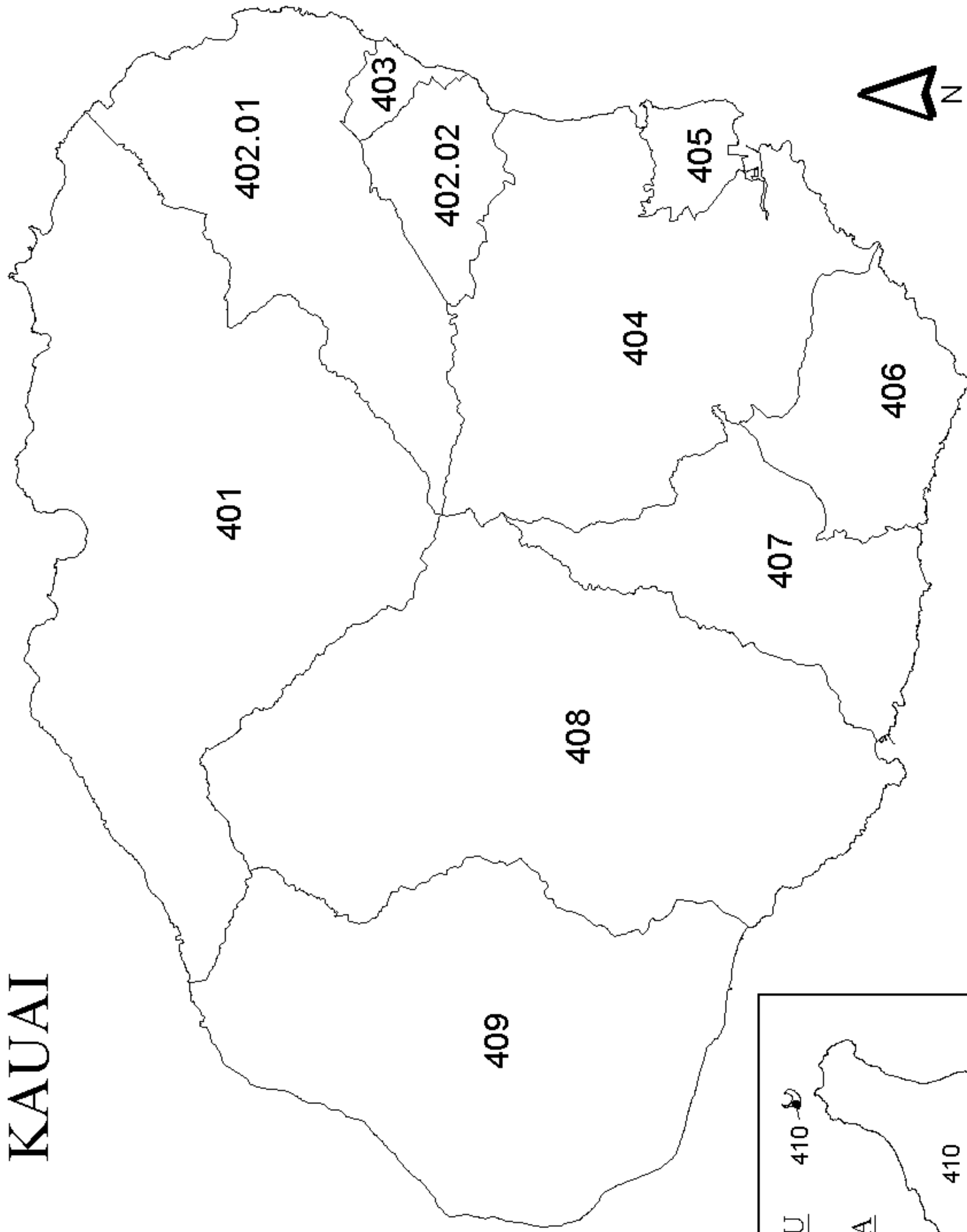

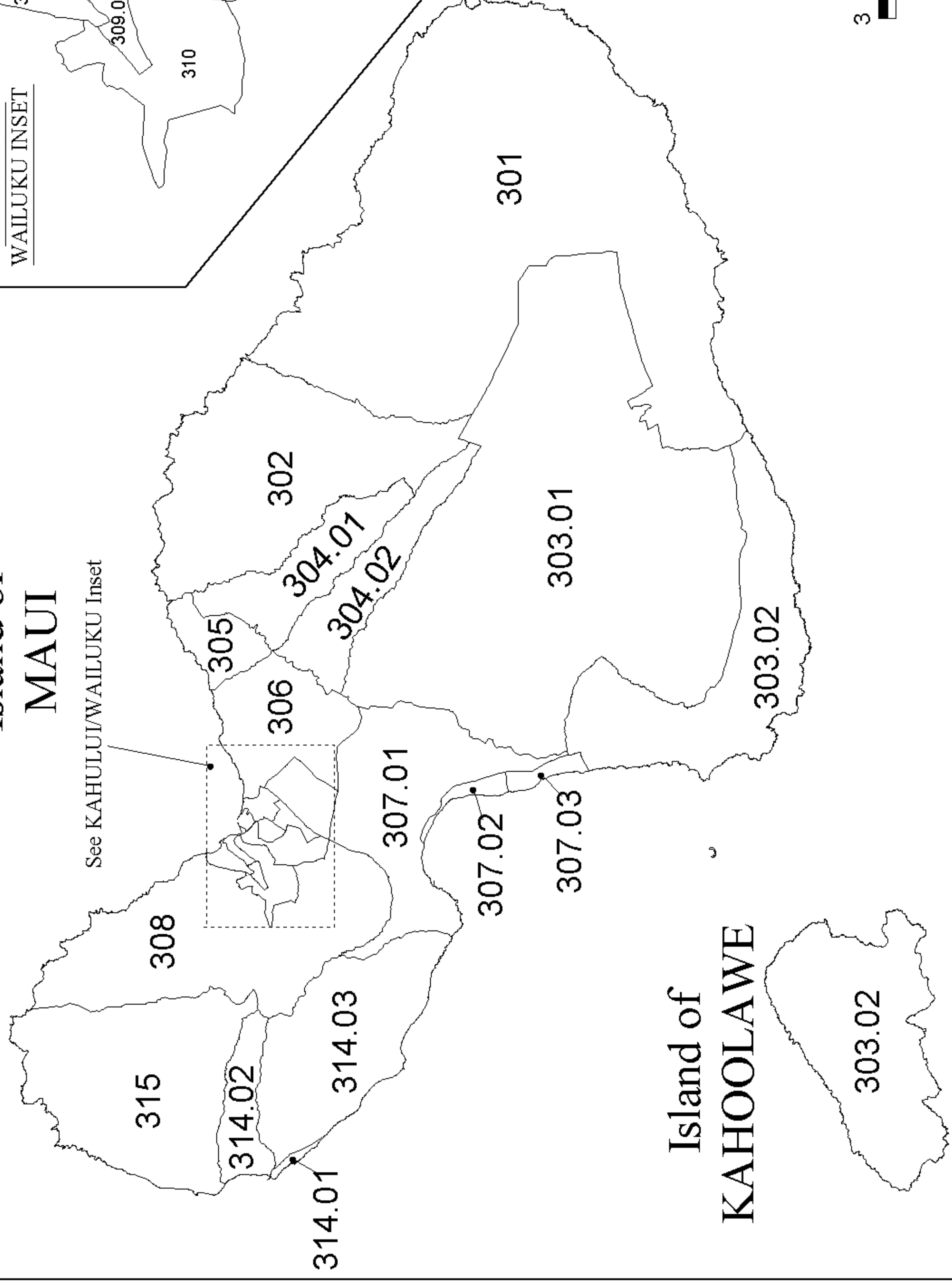

Island of KAUAI

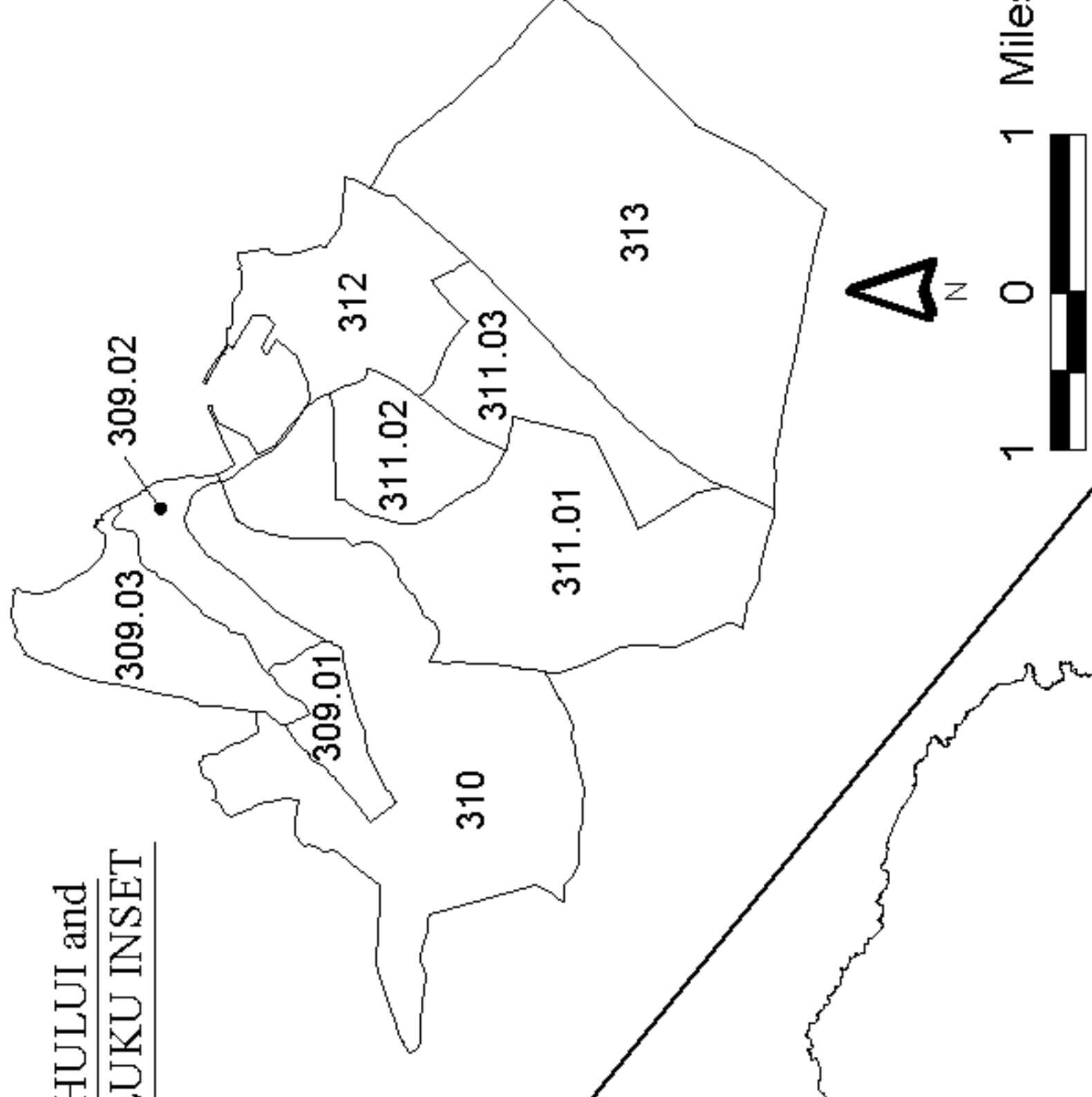

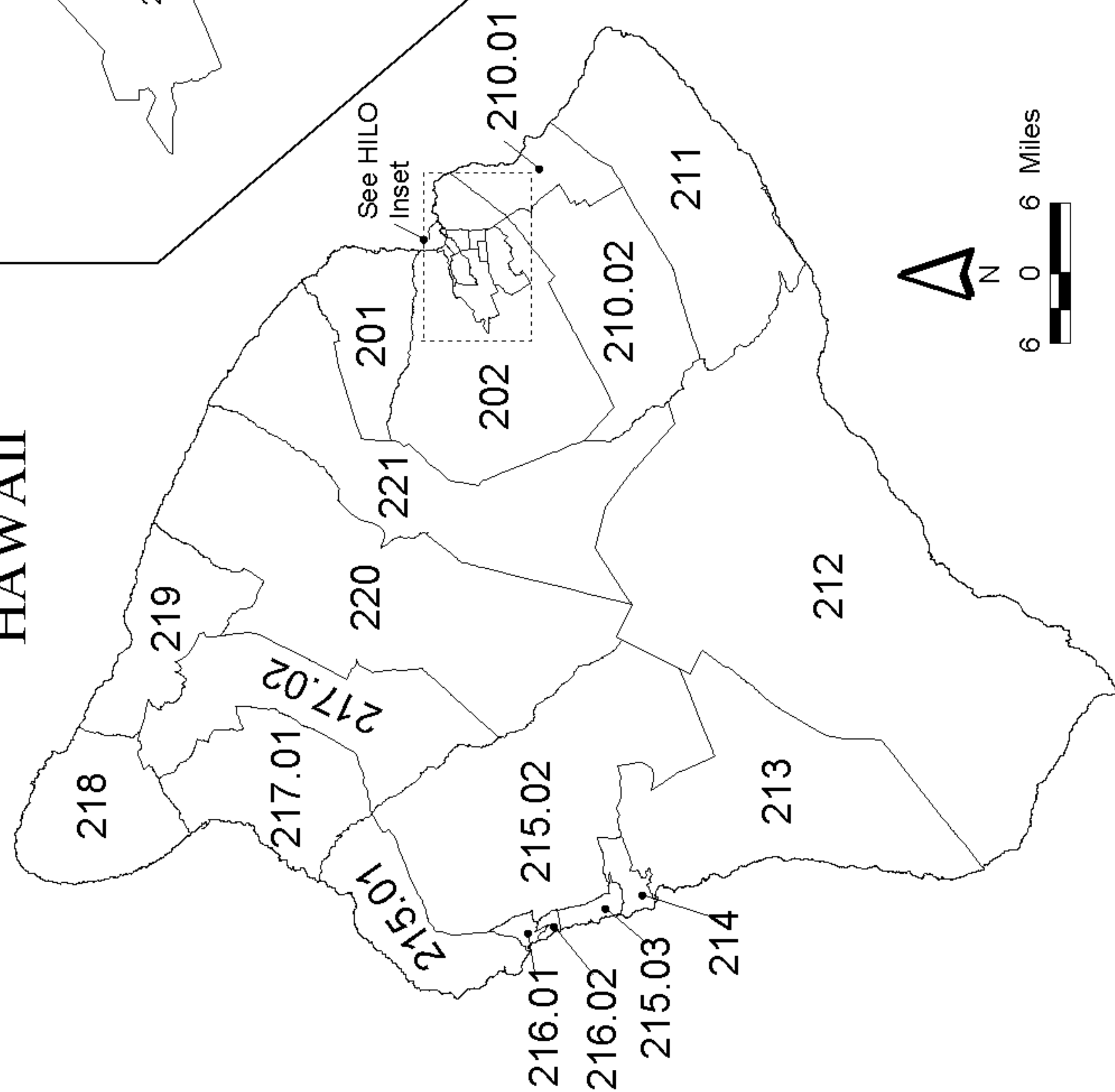

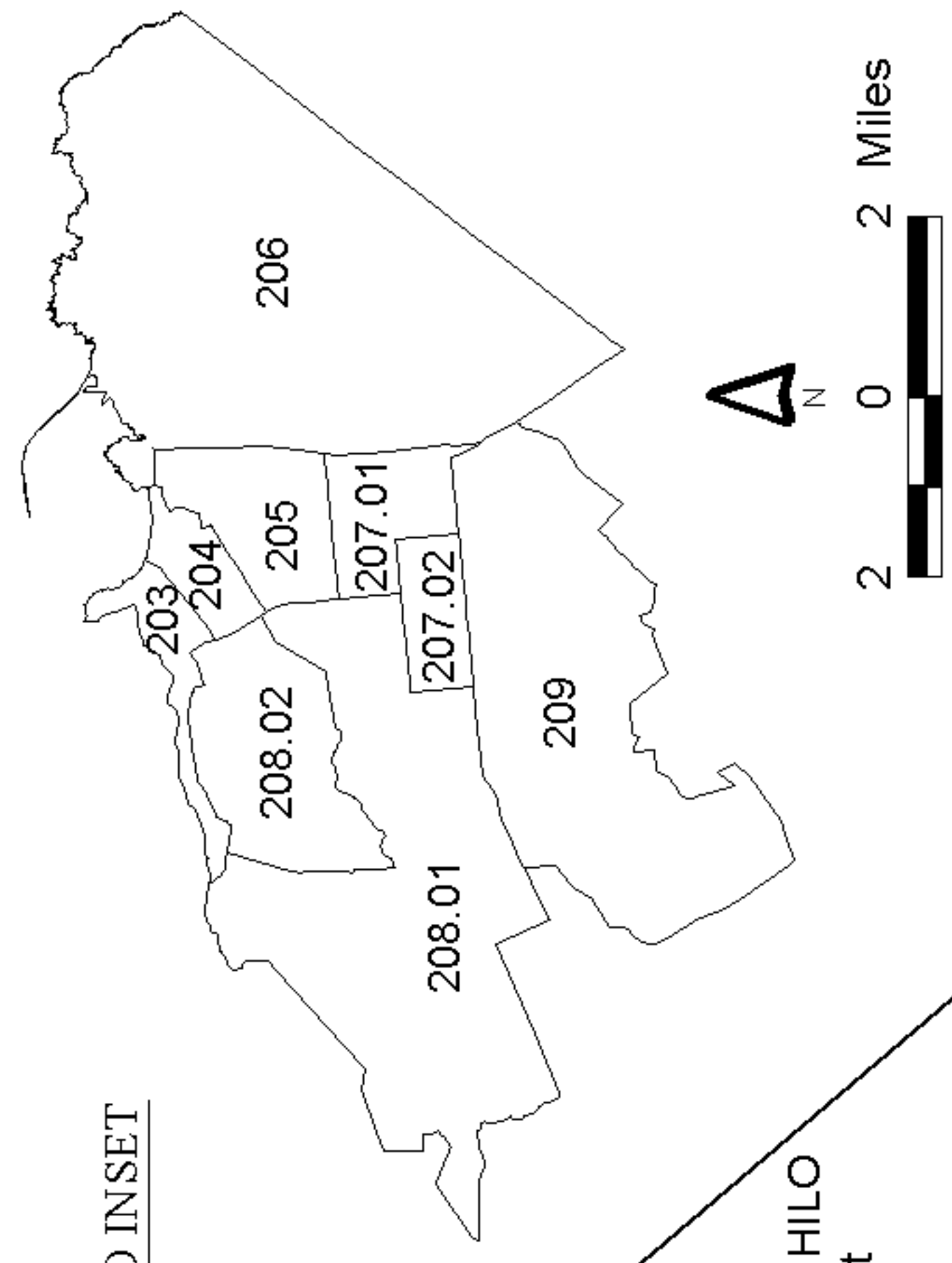

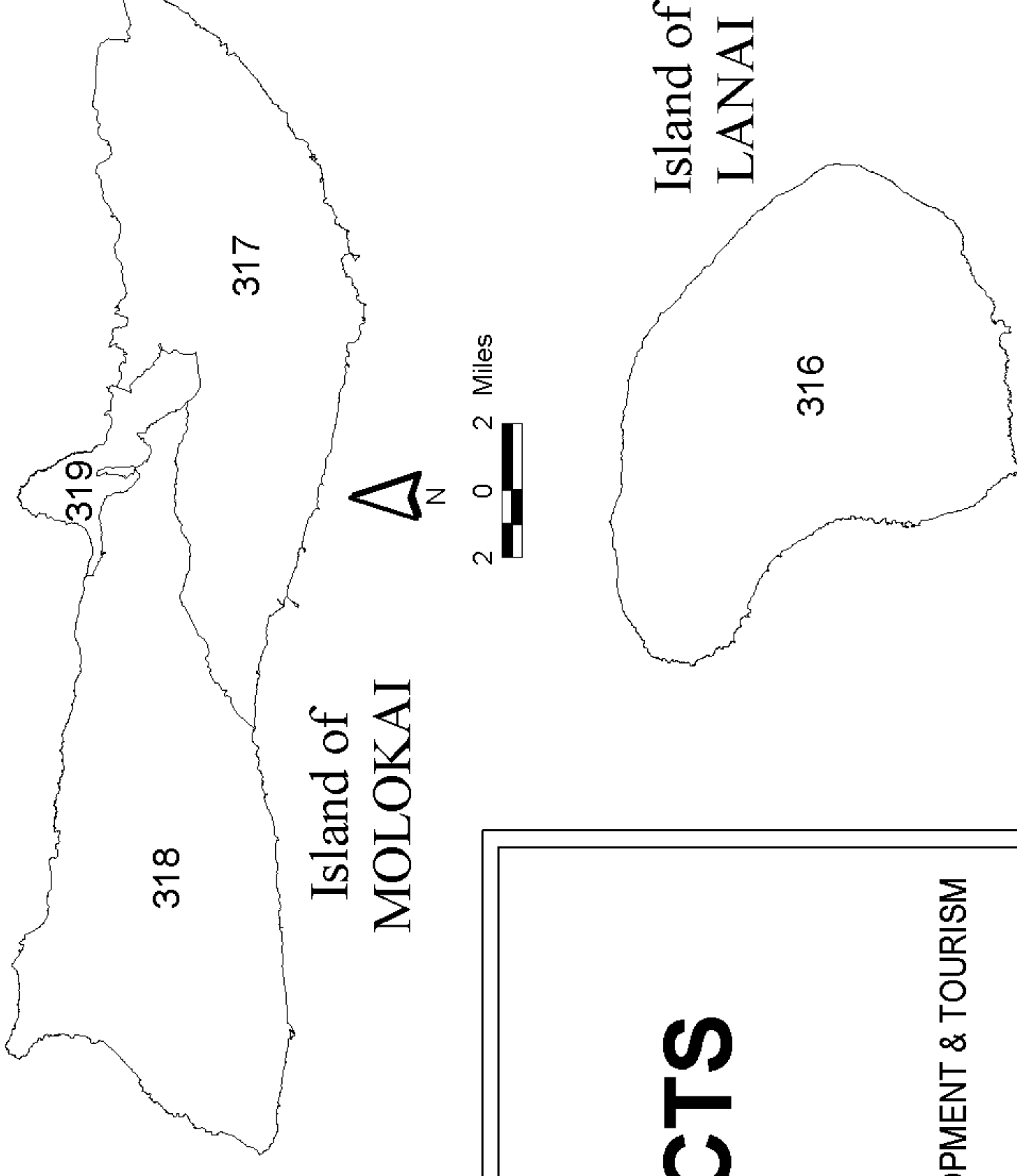

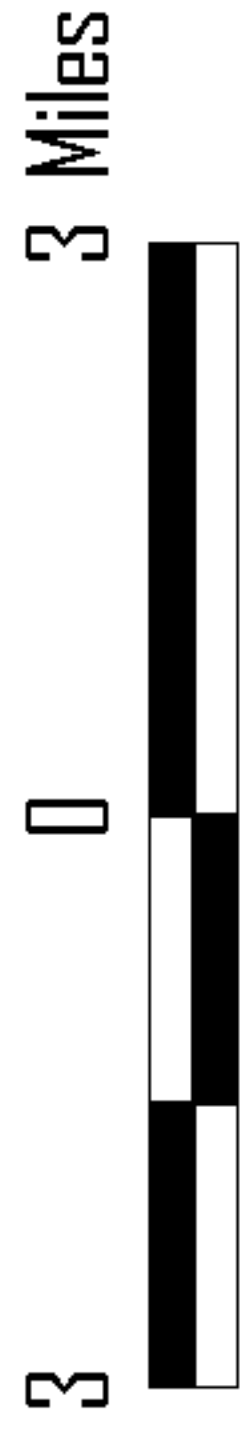


