2006 ACS Universe

- Total resident population of the United State and Puerto Rico
- Household population in 2005 and prior ACS years
- Group Quarters population added to sample in 2006

Residence Rules

- Resident of a housing unit if a person
 - Lives there year round
 - Lives there more than 2 months but not year
 - Is living there now with no other place to live
 - Is away now for 2 months or less
- Not a resident of a housing unit if a person
 - Lives there 2 months or less with another residence
 - Is away now for more than 2 months

USCENSUSBUREAU

ACS Produces Period Estimates

- Describes the characteristics of an area over a specific period of time
- Contrasts with point-in-time estimates that describe the characteristics of an area on a specific date

USCENSUSBUREAU

Reference Periods

 ACS uses the interview date as the single reference point, or as the end of a reference period, for all data collection.

USCINSUSBUREAU ===

Group Quarters

- Two types of group quarters:
 - 1. Institutional for example, correctional facilities, nursing homes, and mental hospitals
 - 2. Non-institutional for example, college dormitories, military barracks, group homes and shelters
- Group Quarters Population includes all people not living in households
 - This term includes those people residing in group quarters as of the date the ACS was conducted

USCENSUSBUREAU
