

- What is the household income level?
- What is the estimated market share?

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## 2010 Summary File 1 (SF-1)

- More detail than the Demographic Profile
- Similar content as Census 2000 Summary File 1  
Cross tabulations of age, sex, households, families, relationship to householder, characteristics of owners and renters, detailed race and Hispanic or Latino origin groups and group quarters

## Summary File 1 Tables

- **“P” tables:** Population Subjects available down to the **block level**
- **“PCT” tables:** Population Subjects available down to the **census tract level**
- **“PCO” tables:** Population Subjects available down to the **county level**
- **“H” tables:** Housing Subjects available down to the **block level**
- **“HCT” tables:** Housing Subjects available down to the **census tract level**

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

- Ongoing Household Survey
- Goes to about 2.5% of addresses annually
- Produces credible, cost-efficient statistics for decision making at all levels of geography
- Provides data every year on characteristics of communities






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## Differences Between Decennial Census and ACS

- Census – Point in Time Data (April 1<sup>st</sup>.)
- ACS – Period Estimates (Jan 1<sup>st</sup>. – Dec. 31<sup>st</sup>.)
  - 1 Year
  - 3 Year
  - 5 Year

## Inflation Adjustment

- Dollar-valued data items are inflation adjusted to the most recent year for the period
  - Income, rent, home value, and energy costs, etc.
- Adjusted using inflation factors based on the Consumer Price Index (CPI)
- Adjustment designed to put the data into dollars with equal purchasing power

- Detailed Race and Hispanic Groups
- Ancestry Groups
- Tribal Groups
- Population threshold minimum of 50 unweighted sample persons for specific groups
- Similar to Census 2000 Summary File 4

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ACS Data Products	
Data Product	Description
Data Profiles	Provide broad social, economic, housing, and demographic profiles.
Narrative profiles	Summarize the information in the data profiles using concise, nontechnical text.
Comparison profile	Compares over 5-year period selected enhancements.
Selected population profiles	Provide broad social, economic, and housing profiles for a large number of race, ethnic, ancestry, and country/region of birth groups.
Detailed tables	Provide access to the most detailed ACS data and cross tabulations of ACS variables.
Subject tables	Similar to data profiles but include more detailed ACS data, classified by subject.
Ranking tables	Provide state rankings of estimates across 86 key variables.
Geographic comparison tables	Compare geographic areas other than states (e.g., counties or congressional districts) for key variables.
Quick table	Predefined table with frequently requested information for a single geographic area.

## ACS Margin of Error (MOE)

- Margin of Error Definition:

A measure of the precision of an estimate at a given level of confidence (90%, 95%, 99%)  
 -- MOEs at the 90% confidence level for all published ACS estimates

- Confidence Interval Definition:



## Understanding Census Geography

- Geography provides the framework for the collection, tabulation, and dissemination of Census Data
- Success of the Census and Census surveys rest not only on collecting data, but also linking data to correct geographic areas
- Two key questions when accessing data:
  - ✓ Population data tells us: *How many?*
  - ✓ Census Geography tells us: *Where?*

## Census Geography Two Broad Categories

- **Legal and Administrative Entities**  
Geographic areas that originate from legal action, treaties, statutes, ordinances, resolutions, or court decisions.  
Specific examples: Nation, States, Counties, Incorporated Places, American Indian Reservations, Hawaiian Home Lands, Congressional Districts, Voting Districts, School Districts, Traffic Analysis Zones, ZIP Codes
- **Statistical Entities**  
Areas that evolve from practice, custom, usage, or need  
Specific examples: Regions, Divisions, Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSA's), Consolidated MSA's, Primary MSA's, Urbanized Areas, Census County Divisions, Census Tracts, Block Groups, Blocks

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
## Census Geography

### Census Designated Place

- No legally defined corporate limits (unincorporated area)
- Defined by the Census Bureau in co-operation with State, Tribal and local officials
- Identified in data tables by the acronym "CDP" following the place name
- All places in Hawaii are Census Designated Places

## Census Geography

### Census Tract

- Small, relatively permanent statistical subdivision of a county
- Census tracts are designed to be relatively homogeneous units with respect to population characteristics, economic status, & living conditions
- 1,200 to 8,000 population (optimum 4,000)
- 480 to 3,200 housing units
- Aggregate census tracts to delineate communities, neighborhoods, social service delivery areas, planning areas, marketing or trade areas






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## Census Geography



### Block Group

- Subdivision of a census tract
- Block group is the smallest geographic unit for the tabulation of sample data
- Block group consists of all blocks within a census tract with the same beginning number
- 600 to 3,000 population
- 240 to 1,200 housing units

### Block

- Smallest geographic unit for which the Census Bureau tabulates 100% data (decennial census)
- Many blocks correspond to individual city blocks bounded by streets
- However blocks, especially in rural areas, may include many square miles and may have boundaries that are not streets

### Step 4: Select the State of Hawaii

#### 2010 Census - Census Tract Reference Maps

These county-based reference maps show and label the census tracts as delineated in record 2010 Census data dissemination. These maps also show the boundaries and names of American Indian areas, Alaska Native areas, Hawaiian home lands, states, counties, county subdivisions, and census tracts. These maps display a base feature set including roads, railroads, and water bodies. These features are limited as map scale permits. Each county is covered by one or more parent map sheets at a single scale. Inset map sheets at larger scales were created where there are outliers of census tracts that cannot be identified at the parent map scale. No inset map showing the sheet configuration is included for all counties requiring more than one parent map sheet. The map sheet size is 20 by 32 inches.



Each set of census tract reference maps is accompanied by a Census Tract to File; Sheet Relationship file. These semi-color coded maps that include a legend for each census tract within the county, state, and name of the tract, and a list of all map sheet numbers that the tract appears on.
