



Daily Estimated Population Change for the State of Hawaii: 2023 to 2024

On July 1, 2023, the resident population for the State of Hawaii was 1,441,387.

On July 1, 2024, the resident population for the State of Hawaii was 1,446,146.

On average, between July 1, 2023, and July 1, 2024, the State of Hawaii's population increased by 13 people a day. There was a natural increase of 6 people per day while 7 more people moved into the State of Hawaii than moved out of it per day.

There were:

40 births per day

34 deaths per day

33 more people *moving to Hawaii* from foreign countries than *moving out of Hawaii* to foreign countries

Daily Estimated Population Change for Hawaii County: 2023 to 2024

On July 1, 2023, the resident population for Hawaii County was 208,043.

On July 1, 2024, the resident population for Hawaii County was 209,790.

On average, between July 1, 2023 and July 1, 2024, Hawaii County's population increased by 5 people a day. There was a natural decrease of 1 person per day, but 6 more people moved into Hawaii County than moved out of it per day.

There were:

5 births per day

6 deaths per day

4 more people *moving to Hawaii County* from foreign countries than *moving out of Hawaii County* to foreign countries

2 more people *moving to Hawaii County* from another state in the United States than *moving from Hawaii County* to another state

Daily Estimated Population Change for Honolulu County: 2023 to 2024

On July 1, 2023, the resident population for Honolulu County was 994,576.

On July 1, 2024, the resident population for Honolulu County was 998,747.

On average, between July 1, 2023 and July 1, 2024, Honolulu County's population increased by 11 people a day. There was a natural increase of 6 people per day while 5 more people moved into Honolulu County than moved out of it per day.

There were:

29 births per day

23 deaths per day

24 more people *moving to Honolulu County* from foreign countries than *moving out of Honolulu County* to foreign countries

19 more people *moving out of Honolulu County* to another state in the United States than *moving to Honolulu County* from another state

Daily Estimated Population Change for Kauai County: 2023 to 2024

On July 1, 2023, the resident population for Kauai County was 73,933.

On July 1, 2024, the resident population for Kauai County was 73,840.

On average, between July 1, 2023 and July 1, 2024, Kauai County's population did not change daily. There were roughly as many births as deaths per day, and roughly about as many people moving out of Kauai County as moving into it per day.

There were:

2 births per day

2 deaths per day

1 person *moving to Kauai County* from foreign countries as *moving out of Kauai County* to foreign countries

1 person *moving out of Kauai County* to another state in the United States than *moving to Kauai County* from another state

Daily Estimated Population Change for Maui County: 2023 to 2024

On July 1, 2023, the resident population for Maui County was 164,835.

On July 1, 2024, the resident population for Maui County was 163,769.

On average, between July 1, 2023 and July 1, 2024, Maui County's population decreased by 3 people daily. There was a natural increase of 1 person per day, but, on average, 4 more people moved out of Maui County than moved to it per day.

There were:

4 births per day

4 deaths per day

3 more people *moving to Maui County* from foreign countries than *moving out of Maui County* to foreign countries

7 more people *moving out of Maui County* to another state in the United States than *moving to Maui County* from another state

Maui County includes Kalawao County.
