## Why Subcommittees?

- More focused on specific groups/communities

Schools, business communities, ethnic communities, within government agencies

## How the Subcommittees Work?

## Initial List of Subcommittees

## Government Subcommittee (Internal Subcommittee)

Promote awareness of the 2020 Census among government employees by ways such as presentations, bulletin board, posters and other promotional materials.

## Media Subcommittee

Creates and facilitates ways to get the census message to all community residents, using all available sources such as local newspapers, newsletters, fliers, local festivals, billboards, radio, and television.

## Business and Outreach Subcommittee

Creates and coordinates activities that involve businesses in census awareness, such as distribution of census information and census messages on packaging (grocery bags), and the inclusion of the census logo and message on sales promotion materials. Collaborates with community organizations to inform residents of the importance of participating in the 2020 Census and the benefits derived from census data.

## Education Subcommittee

Facilitates census awareness for local schools from prekindergarten through twelfth grade, as well as postsecondary education institutions in the area. May also encourage school administrators, teachers, and students to use "Census In Schools" materials.
