## *Introduction*

Understanding the demographics of an area is crucial for answering many fundamental questions. Governments and organizations utilize this information to comprehend the unique needs of different racial groups and to develop targeted policies. Businesses may use these data to identify potential markets and understand consumer preferences. This report was prepared to provide a precise and extensive understanding of Samoan population living in Hawaii in 2020, based on data from the U.S. Census Bureau's 2020 Decennial Census.

Data in this report are presented under two race definitions: "race alone" and "race alone or in combination". "Race alone" refers to individuals who reported only one race (e.g., full Samoan). "Race alone or in combination" represents all individuals who reported that race, whether as a single identity or combined with other races (e.g., full or part Samoan). It should be noted that the sum of all "race alone or in combination" categories will exceed the total population because these categories are not mutually exclusive. For instance, an individual who reported both Samoan and Chinese would be included in the "Samoan in combination" category and the "Chinese in combination" category.

The tables in the distribution section offer a dual perspective on the population data, providing both the absolute number of individuals in a racial group and their percentages of the total population. The absolute number is useful for understanding the scale and volume of people within a specific geographic area, which is vital for effective policy planning and resource allocation. Percentages, on the other hand, are essential for identifying racial diversity and concentration, serving as a crucial comparative metric that enables stakeholders to assess the relative representation of a group in an area.

The small-area analysis in this report uses the U.S. Census Bureau's geographic level of census tracts. The 2020 Census included 436 census tracts in Hawai'i, four of which had no population. Hawaii's populated census tracts are distributed as follows: 326 in Honolulu County, 43 in Hawai'i County, 45 in Maui and Kalawao Counties, and 18 in Kaua'i County. Populations within these census tracts ranged from 1 to 11,046 people.

The present report is a part of the 2020 Census racial group report series being released by the Hawaii Department of Business, Economic Development & Tourism (DBEDT).

### *Data Source*

The data in this report stems from the [2020 Decennial Census: Detailed Demographic Housing Characteristics File A](#) which originally released on September 21<sup>st</sup>, 2023. In this release were detailed counts and sex-by-age statistics for detailed racial and ethnic groups such as Samoan, Chinese, and Japanese.

## Samoans in Hawaii Population

Table 1 presents the top 25 largest race groups in Hawaii in 2020 for two race definitions: “race alone” and “race alone or in combination with other race(s)”. Reflecting the prevalence of multiracial identities in Hawaii, the “race alone or in combination” figures are substantially higher than the “race alone” figures for almost all races included in the table.

In 2020, the Samoan “race alone” group consisted of 17,304 individuals, accounting for 1.2 percent of Hawaii’s total population. While the population size increased when including those who identified as Samoan in combination with other races, the group remains a smaller demographic compared to the State’s largest racial groups. The broader “alone or in combination” group totaled 40,817 individuals, representing 2.8 percent of the State’s population. In the context of Hawaii’s diverse racial landscape, Samoans ranked as the 8th largest “race alone” group and the 9th largest group under the “alone or in combination” definition in 2020.



## Samoan Population: Sex and Age Composition

The Samoan alone population was notably younger than the rest of the State's population. While prime working-age adults (ages 35–64) were the largest cohort at 37.4 percent, young adults (ages 18–34) made up 28.6 percent, compared to 21.8 percent statewide. Conversely, the share of seniors (ages 65 and older) was lower at 9.8 percent, roughly half the State's share of 19.4 percent.

This youthful demographic tilt was even more pronounced within the Samoan alone or in combination population. Nearly four in ten individuals (39.1 percent) in this broader group were children or school-age (ages 0–17), nearly double the statewide proportion for that age range. Consequently, the senior population comprised a very small fraction of this multiracial group, accounting for only 5.7 percent. These figures highlight that the growth of Hawaii's Samoan community is driven predominantly by its younger generations.

The 2020 Census showed that Hawaii's Samoan population was slightly more male leaning overall: about 106 males per 100 females in the Samoan alone population, and about 104 males per 100 females in the Samoan alone or in combination group. As in Hawaii overall and U.S. population, the sex ratio varied by age - more males at younger ages and more females at older ages.

In all age groups younger than 65, males outnumbered females. In contrast, the ratio of the older population (65+) shifted to less than 90 males per 100 females. This pattern was evident regardless of whether individuals identifying as Samoan in combination were included or excluded.

The share of mixed-race individuals within the Samoan alone or in combination group differed by age. Samoan children (ages 0-17) were much more likely to be multiracial as 73.8 percent were Samoan in combination with one or more other races.


In contrast, older Samoans were predominantly identified as Samoan alone. Fewer than 3 in 10 individuals age 65 and older (27.2 percent) and less than half of those who are age 35-64 (42.5 percent) identified as Samoan in combination with other races.

Among young adults (ages 18-34), the distribution was almost even, with about 56.1 percent identifying as Samoan in combination alone and about 43.9 percent identifying as Samoan alone.

## Distribution of Samoan Population

While the proportion of those who identified as “Samoan alone or in combination” was significantly higher than those who identified as Samoan alone across the State, the presence of the population varied by county and remained a relatively small demographic even in its most concentrated areas.

Much of the Samoan community was on Honolulu County, where the Samoan alone made-up 1.6 percent of residents in the county, then rose to 3.5 percent when including mixed-race Samoans. In Hawaii County, those who were Samoan alone represented a marginal 0.4 percent which increased to 1.3 percent when including those who were Samoan in combination. The Samoan community in Maui County was mostly concentrated on Maui Island, with a little over 200 who identified as Samoan on Lanai and Molokai combined. Kauai County maintained the smallest Samoan presence of all the counties, both in absolute number and as a proportion of the county’s total population.

Island totals are calculated by aggregating data from all census tracts within each island and may not be accurate due to the noise applied to protect confidentiality.

Tables 5 and 6 display the top ten census tracts with the largest Samoan alone populations and the highest percentage of the group in the area’s population. The largest Samoan alone population was recorded in Laie on Oahu’s North Shore. Most other top-ranking tracts were located in suburban areas, specifically on Oahu’s west side (Lualualei Transmitter, Maili Beach Park, and Waianae Valley Road), Waipahu (Waipahu Intermediate and Pacific Supermarket), and Aiea (Aloha Stadium). Several tracts near Honolulu’s urban center in Kalihi- including Linapuni St, Kalena drive, and Fern Elementary school – also featured notable concentrations of the Samoan alone population.

The census tracts with the highest percentages of the Samoan alone race group largely mirrored those with the largest Samoan alone populations. In Waipahu, the Samoan alone population made up 18.2 percent of the Waipahu Intermediate School tract's population. In Kalihi's Linapuni census tract, the share was 16.1 percent, while the Kalena Drive tract followed at 9.9 percent. These figures represent the peak concentrations for the group, illustrating that while the race group is a small demographic statewide, it maintains distinct cultural hubs within specific neighborhoods.

Tables 7 and 8 display the top ten census tracts with the largest Samoan alone or in combination populations and the highest percentage of Samoan alone or in combination in the area's population. When including individuals identifying as Samoan in combination with other races, the size of the Samoan community more than doubled in Laie. Two other tracts on Oahu's north shore - Turtle Bay and the Hauula- emerged among the top ten largest Samoan population under this broader definition.

In terms of the proportion of the area's population, the highest concentration was recorded in the Linapuni Street tract in Kalihi surpassing the Waipahu Intermediate School tract when accounting for mixed-race Samoans. The North Shore tracts of Laie, Turtle Bay, and Hauula also ranked among the top ten for the highest percentages of Samoans alone or in combination.
