Introduction

Understanding the demographics of an area is crucial for answering many fundamental questions. Governments and organizations utilize this information to comprehend the unique needs of different racial groups and to develop targeted policies. Businesses may use these data to identify potential markets and understand consumer preferences. This report was prepared to provide a precise and extensive understanding of Vietnamese population living in Hawaii in 2020, based on data from the U.S. Census Bureau's 2020 Decennial Census.

Data in this report are presented under two race definitions: "race alone" and "race alone or in combination". "Race alone" refers to individuals who reported only one race (e.g., full Vietnamese). "Race alone or in combination" represents all individuals who reported that race, whether as a single identity or combined with other races (e.g., full or part Vietnamese). It should be noted that the sum of all "race alone or in combination" categories will exceed the total population because these categories are not mutually exclusive. For instance, an individual who reported both Vietnamese and Chinese would be included in the "Vietnamese in combination" category and the "Chinese in combination" category.

The tables in the distribution section offer a dual perspective on the population data, providing both the absolute number of individuals in a racial group and their percentages of the total population. The absolute number is useful for understanding the scale and volume of people within a specific geographic area, which is vital for effective policy planning and resource allocation. Percentages, on the other hand, are essential for identifying racial diversity and concentration, serving as a crucial comparative metric that enables stakeholders to assess the relative representation of a group in an area.

The small-area analysis in this report uses the U.S. Census Bureau's geographic level of census tracts. The 2020 Census included 436 census tracts in Hawai'i, four of which had no population. Hawaii's populated census tracts are distributed as follows: 326 in Honolulu County, 43 in Hawai'i County, 45 in Maui and Kalawao Counties, and 18 in Kaua'i County. Populations within these census tracts ranged from 1 to 11,046 people.

The present report is a part of the 2020 Census racial group report series being released by the Hawaii Department of Business, Economic Development & Tourism (DBEDT).

Data Source

The data in this report stems from the [2020 Decennial Census: Detailed Demographic Housing Characteristics File A](#) which originally released on September 21st, 2023. In this release were detailed counts and sex-by-age statistics for detailed racial and ethnic groups such as Vietnamese, Chinese, and Japanese.

Vietnamese in Hawaii Population

Table 1 presents the top 25 largest race groups in Hawaii in 2020 for two race definitions: “race alone” and “race alone or in combination with other race(s)”. Reflecting the prevalence of multiracial identities in Hawaii, the “race alone or in combination” figures are substantially higher than the figures for “race alone” for almost all races included in the table.

In 2020, the Vietnamese alone group consisted of 11,231 individuals, comprising 0.8 percent of Hawaii’s total population. The population size was 46 percent larger under the broader “Vietnamese alone or in combination” definition, which totaled 16,452 individuals and represented 1.1 percent of the state’s total population. Within the context of Hawaii’s diverse racial landscape, the Vietnamese community represented one of the smaller segments among the state’s major racial groups, ranking as the 9th largest group under the “race alone” definition and the 10th largest under the broader “alone or in combination” definition.

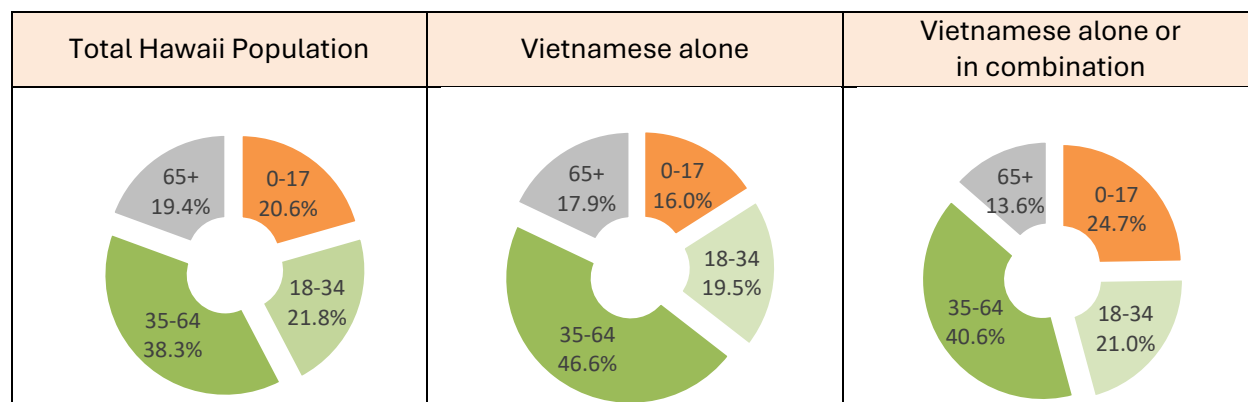

Vietnamese Population: Sex and Age Composition

In 2020, the Vietnamese alone population was more concentrated in its working-age years than the general state population. While the senior share (17.9 percent) was slightly below the state average of 19.4 percent, the prime working-age cohort (ages 35–64) was significantly larger, accounting for 46.6 percent of the group compared to the state’s 38.3 percent. Conversely, children and school-age individuals (ages 0–17) made up only 16.0 percent, falling well below the statewide average of 20.6 percent.

This profile shifted noticeably younger under the broader Vietnamese alone or in combination definition. In this group, the share of children (ages 0–17) rose to 24.7 percent, exceeding the state average, while the senior population (65 and older) dropped to 13.6 percent. While the 35–64 age group remained the largest segment at 40.6 percent, it aligned more closely with the statewide average than the Vietnamese alone group, highlighting a higher prevalence of multiracial identity among younger generations.

In 2020, the sex ratio of the Vietnamese population in Hawaii followed the typical trend of more males at younger ages and more females at older ages. However, the Vietnamese population was noticeably female-leaning, with 83 males per 100 females among the Vietnamese alone population. This gender imbalance was most prominent among seniors (65 and older), where there were only 62 males per 100 females. When including those identifying as Vietnamese in combination with other races, the ratio became more balanced but still noticeably female-leaning with 87 males per 100 females.

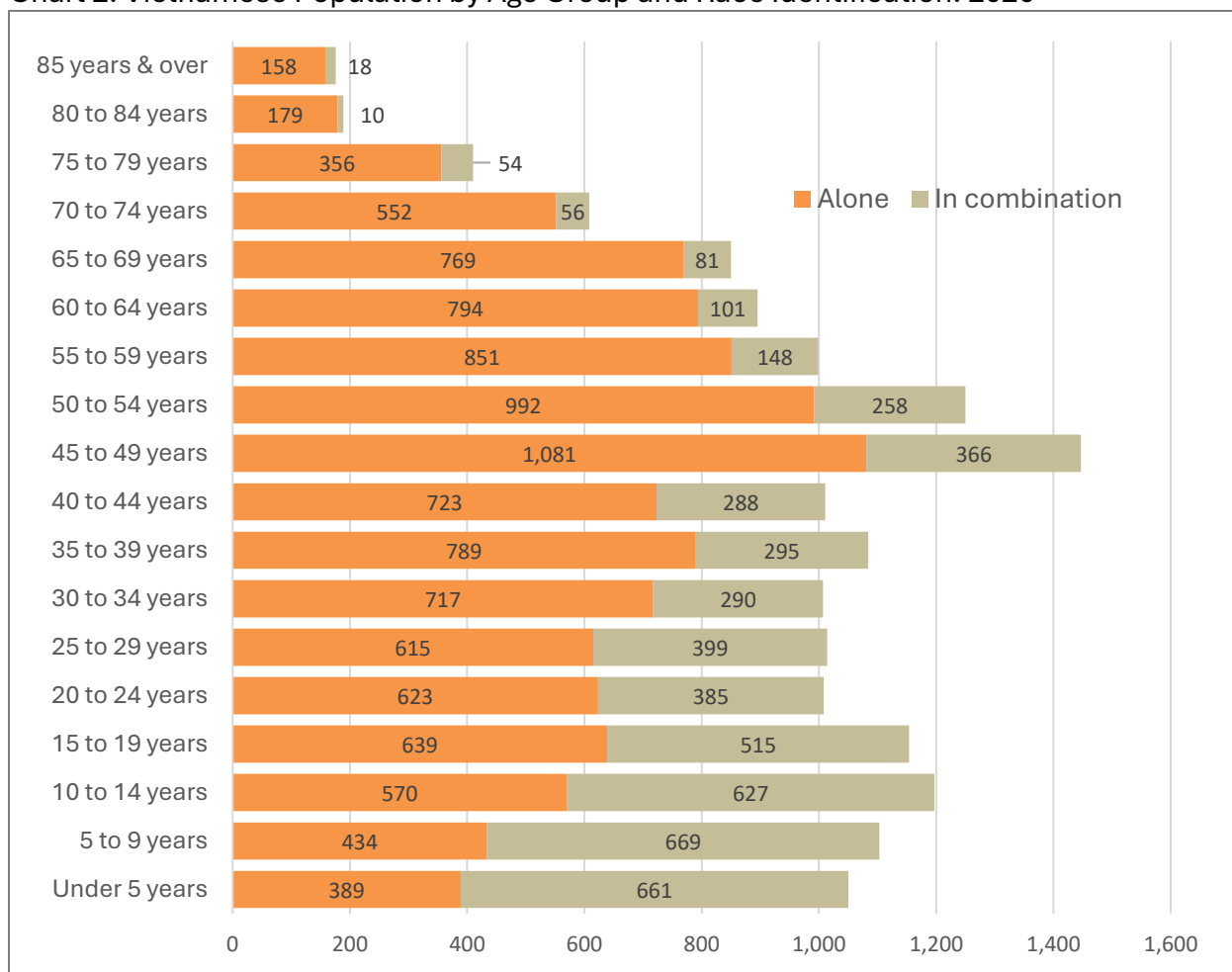
Overall, less than one-third of the individuals within the Vietnamese alone or in combination groups identified as multiracial (31.7 percent), a relatively low share compared to other major Asian race groups in Hawaii. However, this proportion varied significantly by age, with younger generation being much more likely to identify as multiracial. In 2020, Vietnamese children and school-age individuals (ages 0-17) were the most likely to be multiracial, with 55.9 percent identifying as Vietnamese in combination with other races. Among young adults (ages 18-34), this proportion was notably lower, with slightly over one-third of the population identifying as multiracial.

In contrast, older Vietnamese residents predominantly identified as Vietnamese alone. Fewer than one in four individuals in the 35-64 age range (21.8 percent) and fewer than one in ten seniors aged 65 and older (9.8 percent) identified as Vietnamese in combination with other races.

Distribution of Vietnamese Population

In 2020, the Vietnamese population was heavily concentrated within Honolulu County, with approximately 90 percent of the population under both race definitions residing on the island of Oahu. Specifically, there were 10,053 individuals identifying as Vietnamese alone on Oahu, a figure that rose to 14,669 when including those identifying as Vietnamese in combination with other races. Despite this concentration, the group remained a small demographic even in its most populous county; the Vietnamese alone group accounted for 1.0 percent of Oahu's residents, while the alone or in combination group represented 1.4 percent of the county's total population.

The proportion of the Vietnamese population in neighbor island counties was consistently small across both race definitions. The Vietnamese alone population accounted for only 0.2 to 0.3 percent of each county's total population, while the Vietnamese under the broader definition represented 0.3 to 0.5 percent. In 2020, every county outside of Honolulu recorded fewer than 600 individuals who identified as Vietnamese alone and fewer than 900 individuals who identified as Vietnamese alone or in combination.

Island totals are calculated by aggregating data from all census tracts within each island and may not be accurate due to the noise applied to protect confidentiality.

Tables 5 and 6 display the top ten census tracts with the largest Vietnamese alone populations and the highest percentage of the group in the area's population. All ten tracts with the largest population were located on Oahu, with nine situated within Honolulu's Urban core. Chinatown, a tract at the center of the County's urban core, had the highest number of individuals identifying as Vietnamese alone. The Stadium Mall tract ranked second and was notable as the only tract in the top ten located outside of Urban Honolulu. The Farrington High school tract in Kalihi ranked third, though the Vietnamese alone population in this tract and those ranked below it consisted of fewer than 200 individuals.

The top ten of the highest percentage of the Vietnamese alone population largely mirrored those of the largest Vietnamese alone population. Chinatown ranked first again, as individuals identifying as Vietnamese alone made up 11.2 percent of the tract's total population. The Mayor Wright Housing tract in Kalihi ranked second, with 7.6 percent of the tract's population identifying as Vietnamese alone. Closely behind was the Mahiai Street tract where the race group made up 7.2 percent of the area's population. All ten of the tracts with the highest percentages were a part of the Urban Honolulu area.

Tables 7 and 8 display the top ten census tracts for the Vietnamese alone or in combination population. For the most part, these rankings mirrored the Vietnamese alone population, with a few exceptions. When including multiracial individuals, the Kakaako Waterfront Park tract (ranked 6th) and the Bingham Tract (ranked 10th) entered the top ten. Other tracts in the list saw small increases in their Vietnamese population size when multiracial identities were accounted for.

The inclusion of individuals identifying as Vietnamese in combination with other races slightly increased the proportion of the population for all top tracts. In Chinatown, the Vietnamese share reached 12.8 percent under the broader definition, while those identifying as Vietnamese made up close to 10 percent of the Mayor Wright Housing tract's population. Other tracts saw similar proportion changes under the broader race group definition.
