County Population Facts for the State of Hawaii

The U.S. Census Bureau released population estimates at the county level on March 22, 2018. The release contained population data from 2010 to 2017.

The data include total county population and the components of population changes, but no details by age, sex, and race are available at this time.

The following are some interesting facts about Hawaii's population from 2010 onward:

Annual growth rates. Between July 1, 2010 and July 1, 2017, the statewide population grew at an annual rate of 0.7%. Growth rates for neighbor island counties were around 1.0% per year. The City and County of Honolulu growth rate was lower: 0.5% per year. The growth of the statewide resident population between July 1, 2010 and July 1, 2017 was primarily due to natural increase (births less deaths) and international migration.

Growth has slowed in all counties in recent years. Only in Hawaii County has growth stayed around 1.0% year-over-year. The City and County of Honolulu had negative growth in 2016 and 2017 due to out-migration of people leaving for the mainland.

<u>County's share of the state population.</u> The City and County of Honolulu's share of the population has seen a slight decrease over the past five years. Its share was 69.3% of the population in 2017, down from to 69.5% in 2016. The remaining counties had slight increases in their share of the population from 2016—Hawaii County, 14.0%; Maui County, 11.7%; and Kauai County, 5.1%.

Components of change. The average number of births in the state was 18,661 per year, and the average number of deaths was 10,981 per year. The result was an average natural increase of 7,680 persons per year between July 1, 2010 and July 1, 2017. There was an average of 7,537 net in-migrants coming from foreign countries, and an average of 6,014 net out-migrants going to the mainland. The result was a net gain of 1,523 people a year for the state from migration during the same period.

Births by county. The City and County of Honolulu accounted for 71.8% of births in the state between July 1, 2010 and July 1, 2017. Hawaii County had 12.9%, Maui County had 10.6%, and Kauai County had 4.7% of total births during the same time period.

Deaths by county. The City and County of Honolulu had 69.2% of deaths in the state between July 1, 2010 and July 1, 2017. Hawaii County had 15.0%, Maui County had 10.6%, and Kauai County had 5.2% of total deaths during the same time period.

Net migration by county. There was a net average of 6,853 people per year moving from the City and County of Honolulu to the mainland. There was a net average of 5,773 people per year moving to the City and County of Honolulu from foreign countries. Thus, the City and County of Honolulu saw a net loss of 1,080 people a year during the July 1, 2010 to July 1, 2017 period. The neighbor island counties had net in-migration from both the mainland and from foreign countries during the July 1, 2010 to July 1, 2017 period. Average net total migration per year during the period was 1,388 for Hawaii County; 806 for Maui County; and 409 for Kauai County.
