

Daily Estimated Population Change for the State of Hawaii: 2018 to 2019

On July 1, 2018, the resident population for the State of Hawaii was 1,420,593.

On July 1, 2019, the resident population for the State of Hawaii was 1,415,872.

On average, between July 1, 2018 and July 1, 2019, the State of Hawaii's population decreased 13 people a day. There was a natural increase of 11 people per day, but, on average, 24 more people moved out of the State of Hawaii than moved to the State of Hawaii per day.

There were:

46 births per day

35 deaths per day

14 more people *moving to Hawaii* from foreign countries than *moving out of Hawaii* to foreign countries

38 more people *moving out of Hawaii* to another state than *moving to Hawaii* from another state
