Daily Estimated Population Change for the State of Hawaii: 2021 to 2022

On July 1, 2021, the resident population for the State of Hawaii was 1,447,154.

On July 1, 2022, the resident population for the State of Hawaii was 1,440,196.

On average, between July 1, 2021 and July 1, 2022, the State of Hawaii's population decreased 19 people a day. There was a natural increase of 7 people per day, but, on average, 26 more people moved out of the State of Hawaii than moved to the State of Hawaii per day.

There were:

43 births per day

37 deaths per day

16 more people *moving to Hawaii* from foreign countries than *moving out of Hawaii* to foreign countries

42 more people *moving out of Hawaii* to another state than *moving to Hawaii* from another state

Daily Estimated Population Change for Hawaii County: 2021 to 2022

On July 1, 2021, the resident population for Hawaii County was 203,792.

On July 1, 2022, the resident population for Hawaii County was 206,315.

On average, between July 1, 2021 and July 1, 2022, Hawaii County's population increased 7 people a day. There was effectively no natural change per day, but 7 more people moved into Hawaii County than moved out of Hawaii County per day.

There were:

6 births per day

6 deaths per day

2 more people *moving to Hawaii County* from foreign countries than *moving out of Hawaii County* to foreign countries

5 more people *moving to Hawaii County* from another county in the United States than *moving from Hawaii County* to another county in the United States

Daily Estimated Population Change for Honolulu County: 2021 to 2022

On July 1, 2021, the resident population for Honolulu County was 1,004,673.

On July 1, 2022, the resident population for Honolulu County was 995,638.

On average, between July 1, 2021 and July 1, 2022, Honolulu County's population decreased 25 people a day. There was a natural increase of 5 people per day, but, on average, 30 more people moved out of Honolulu County than moved to Honolulu County per day.

There were:

31 births per day

25 deaths per day

11 more people *moving to Honolulu County* from foreign countries than *moving out of Honolulu County* to foreign countries

42 more people *moving out of Honolulu County* to another county in the United States than *moving to Honolulu County* from another county in the United States

Daily Estimated Population Change for Kauai County: 2021 to 2022

On July 1, 2021, the resident population for Kauai County was 73,791.

On July 1, 2022, the resident population for Kauai County was 73,810.

On average, between July 1, 2021 and July 1, 2022, Kauai County's population did not change daily.

There were:

2 births per day

2 deaths per day

1 more person *moving to Kauai County* from foreign countries than *moving out of Kauai County* to foreign countries

1 more person *moving out of Kauai County* to another county in the United States than *moving to Kauai County* from another county in the United States

Daily Estimated Population Change for Maui County: 2021 to 2022

On July 1, 2021, the resident population for Maui County was 164,898.

On July 1, 2022, the resident population for Maui County was 164,433.

On average, between July 1, 2021 and July 1, 2022, Maui County's population decreased by 1 person a day. There was a natural increase of 1 person per day, but, on average, 2 more people moved out of Maui County than moved to Maui County per day.

There were:

5 births per day

4 deaths per day

2 more people *moving to Maui County* from foreign countries than *moving out of Maui County* to foreign countries

4 more people *moving out of Maui County* to another county in the United States than *moving to Maui County* from another county in the United States

Maui County includes Kalawao County.
