

Daily Estimated Population Change for the State of Hawaii: 2022 to 2023

On July 1, 2022, the resident population for the State of Hawaii was 1,439,399.

On July 1, 2023, the resident population for the State of Hawaii was 1,435,138.

On average, between July 1, 2022 and July 1, 2023, the State of Hawaii's population decreased by 12 people a day. There was a natural increase of 6 people per day, but, on average, 18 more people moved out of the State of Hawaii than moved to the State of Hawaii per day, causing an overall decline.

There were:

42 births per day

35 deaths per day

13 more people *moving to Hawaii* from foreign countries than *moving out of Hawaii* to foreign countries

31 more people *moving out of Hawaii* to another state than *moving to Hawaii* from another state
