

FREE WORKSHOP ON COMMUNITY ASSESSMENT USING CENSUS BUREAU DATA

The public is invited to a free workshop being held on **April 8th** in downtown Honolulu.

This interactive workshop, *Using Census Data to Assess Your Community*, will be taught by Mr. Jerry Wong of the U.S. Census Bureau.

Learn how to use census population and business data to assess the community or service area you are interested in. Become familiar with the prepackaged narrative profiles available for areas within our state. Improve your skills at obtaining key data in an efficient manner using the Bureau's data tools, especially their American FactFinder tool. This tool has been revised to make it easier to locate and access data. Get familiar with these new features that will soon become available, many of which were based on user feedback.

Recent activities of Mr. Wong include webinars on the American Community Survey and the race/ethnicity data. Both of these topics will be included in the workshop.

Mr. Jerry Wong is a Data Dissemination Specialist from the Los Angeles Regional Office of the U.S. Census Bureau. He has been the Bureau trainer for our State of Hawaii for over 20 years. Jerry's experience also includes his role as an advisor to Nielsen—the nation's leading television, radio, and consumer measurement company.
