

Accessing Census Bureau Data—Exercises

1. Community Facts-- How was the 2010 population count for Honolulu County?

Census.gov > Data tab > Data Tools and Apps > American FactFinder
Select Geography> Type in County, place or zipcode
County= Honolulu County > 1st Choice is Population > Default is 2010 Census Count
Get Results

2. Guided Search--What percentage of people in occupied housing units in Honolulu, Hawaii and Maui counties, lived alone (1-person household) in the period 2011-2015?

AFF Guided Search (tab in blue bar)
(Default radio button) I'm looking for information about "housing" (second choice) > Next

(Note Arrow 2. Topics is activated)

Expand Occupancy Characteristic (click on "+") = Household Size

(Your Selections box currently shows 1,540 tables available based on your filter)

Click Next (or you may click Arrow 3. Geographies)

Open select a geographic type = County > Select a state = Hawaii

Select one or more = **Honolulu, Hawaii and Maui** (hold Ctrl key counties > Add to Your Selections

Make certain all three counties are in the Your Selections box > Next

Arrow 4. Race/Ethnic Groups > Skip This Step Arrow 5.

Back to Search Results > (scroll to bottom of search results) click Advanced Search > Continue

- 3. Selected Population Profiles** --Find the most recent information on (1) Native Hawaiian Alone, (2) Native Hawaiian Alone or in any Combination, for the County of Honolulu.

Census.gov > Data tab > Data Tools and Apps > The American FactFinder

(Wait for site to launch or click on URL)

Advanced Search tab

Right-side text box, begin typing: Honolulu

(You may highlight the appropriate line in the drop-down list) > GO

"Were you looking for" box, click on Honolulu County, Hawaii

It will now appear in the Your Selections box, upper left corner

Open Race and Ethnic Groups filter bar > Detailed Groups tab > Race and Hispanic Origin

Expand Basic/Detailed Groups > Basic Groups or if looking for Native Hawaiian alone then choose Detailed groups

Check boxes:

050 Native Hawaiian or other Pacific Islander alone

060 Native Hawaiian or other Pacific Islander alone or in any combination

Scroll to top of frame and click Add

Detailed Groups:

Your two groups should now appear in the Your Selections box

Close Race and Ethnic Groups overlay (or window)

Check boxes:

S0201 Selected Population Profile (2016 ACS 1-year estimates)> Double Click to Add to "Your Selections"

In Search Refine Text Box Type in Data Profiles>GO

Check boxes:

DP02 Selected Social Characteristics (2015 ACS 5-year Selected Population Tables)

DP03 Selected Economic Characteristics (ditto)

DP04 Selected Housing Characteristics (ditto)

Click View and download tables

4. Using Address Search-- for Census Tract, Data and Reference Map of Census Tract

Answer the following questions for your target location UH Jabsom Library, or a location of your choice using the most current dataset (2011-2015 ACS 5-Year Estimates):

- (a) What is the census tract number for 651 Ilalo St., Honolulu, HI**
- (b) How do you create a reference map of this tract?**
- (c) What mode of Transportation had the highest percentage of those that spoke English less than very well?**

Census.gov > Data > Data Tools and Apps > American FactFinder (main page) (lower right of page) Address Search = street address (click)*

*Alternate path: Advanced Search > Geographies filter > Address tab

Select geographies Address tab: enter **651 Ilalo St., Honolulu, HI, 96813**> GO

Answer (a): Census Tract 38, Honolulu County, Hawaii

Answer (b): Click on hyperlink for Census Tract 38, then click Map tab

Instructions (c):

Close reference map (Geographies window) and look down the list of available tables. Click hyperlink for (S0802) Means of Transportation to Work by Selected Characteristics

Answer _____ Public Transportation

Click "Back to Advanced Search" (right side, above table, highlighted in grey)

5. Thematic Map--Make a table of the percent of people living below the poverty level for all CDP's in Honolulu County. Create a thematic map of the results. Change the number of data classes to 2 and define the cutoff percentage as 16.0%.

Advanced Search (from previous exercise), click Continue, then clear all selections from the Your Selections box)

Geographies filter bar > (name tab) > select a geographic type = **city/town**

Select a state = Hawaii> Within County> Honolulu

(Select one or more.) **All Places within Honolulu**> Add to Your Selections Close Geographies window

Refine your search results text box (left side) poverty > GO

Click hyperlink for (S1701) Poverty Status in the Past 12 Months (Dataset? . . .)

Note that in order to retrieve all counties, you need to select the dataset common to all (including those with populations under 20,000) – the 2011-2015 ACS 5-year dataset

Click Create a Map

In the first place listed (Ahuimanu CDP), find the column with the estimate of “Percent below the poverty level” and click on that value (10.5%) > Show Map > This action will pull in all counties

Click Colors and Data Classes

Change Number of classes (currently 5) to 2

Change Classing method to User Defined

Row 1, column 2, enter 16.0

Put cursor in row 2, column 1 > Enter (next value--16.1--autofills > GO

After viewing results, Back to Advanced Search and clear all selections

6. Narrative Profiles--Create a current Narrative Profile for American Indian Area/Alaska Native Area/Hawaiian Home Land: Select Waianae Hawaiian Home Land

Instructions: Census.gov footer > People & Households column = American Community Survey

(left column) Data > Data Tables & Tools

(blue link mid-page center) generate a Narrative Profile

(WAIT until page loads and a map of the U.S. appears!)

Step 1: move radio button to Search Using Dropdown Menus

Step 2: American Indian Area/Alaska Native Area/Hawaiian Home Land

Step 3: Choose a state = Hawaii > Choose = Hawaiian Home Land > Waianae Hawaiian Home Land >Get Profile

7. 2016 population estimates--Find most current tables for Honolulu, HI. (or another County)

AFF Advanced Search > Topics > Dataset > 2016 Population Estimates > Close Topics window

Refine Your Search Results text box (right side) Honolulu county, Hawaii > GO

Check in checkboxes for PEPANNRES, PEPTCOMP, PEPASYSEX > View

PEPANNRES gives you an annual estimate of population since the last census
Click for Result 2 of 2 with top right arrow

PEPTCOMP provides estimates of components of population change

PEPSYSEX gives you single year age data

8. Comparison Profiles-- Compare selected counties using 2016 1 Year Estimates Comparative Profiles.

(Note the 2016 1 Year comparison profiles are already tested for statistical significance. An * indicates that the estimate is significantly different (at a 90% confidence level) than the estimate from the most current year. A "c" indicates the estimates for that year and the current year are both controlled; a statistical test is not appropriate). Review comparison profiles for what's trending

In Advanced Search > Topics>Data Products> Comparison Profiles> Add

In Search Results Select: Tables CP02, CP03, CP04

Search Refine > Geography> Type in Honolulu County > Add to Your Selections.
View and download tables.

9. American Community Survey (2005-2009 and 2010-2015) data sets-- *Pull up Tables of the percent of people living below the poverty level for selected counties in Hawaii comparing 2005-2009 ACS 5 Year Data with 2010-2014 ACS 5 Year Data. Then download or save the link or query.*

Advanced Search (from previous exercise), click Continue, then clear all selections from the
Your Selections box)

Geographies filter bar > (List tab) > select a geographic type = County> Select a
state = Hawaii

(Select one or more . . .) Select Counties of interest in Hawaii > Hawaii, Honolulu, Maui,
Kauai > Add to Your Selections> Close Geographies window

Refine your search results text box (left side) Data Profiles > GO

Click hyperlink for **DP03 2010-2014 ACS 5 Year Data**.

Download into excel and then download the 2005-2009 data set.

Type in **2009** in Refine your search text box. You should see Data profiles for 2005-2009

Select **DP03**

Census.gov > Data tab > Data Tools and Apps > The American FactFinder

(Wait for site to launch or click on URL)

Advanced Search tab

Open up Topics> Business and Industry> Business Owner > Select Owner's Race and Ethnicity> Close

Open up Geography Tab>County> Within State> Hawaii> Select Counties of interest> Hawaii, Honolulu and Maui> Click Add > Close Geography Filter

In Results> Select **SB1200CSA04**
