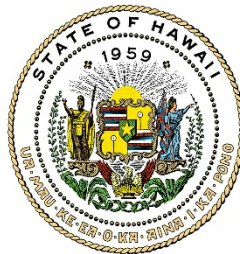
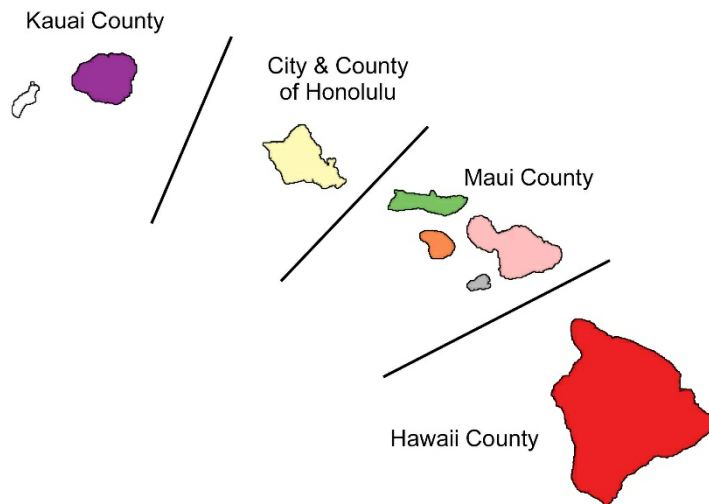

This report presents annual statistics on social, business and economic trends for the State and each of its four counties, covering the years 2005 to 2024 (1990 to 2024 in spreadsheets), and was produced by the Hawaii State Department of Business, Economic Development & Tourism's Research and Economic Analysis Division. It was compiled and edited by Mary Blewitt, Economist.

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A. Population and Housing

This section presents statistics regarding Hawaii's resident and de facto populations, vital statistics (births and deaths), and housing inventory for the state of Hawaii and its four counties.

Population data are primarily sourced from the U.S. Census Bureau's annual estimates, with additional figures on visitors present and residents absent provided by the Hawaii State Department of Business, Economic Development & Tourism (DBEDT). Vital statistics are provided by the Hawaii State Department of Health (DOH), while housing unit data are sourced from the U.S. Census Bureau's Population and Housing Unit Estimates program.

For historical data and long-term trends, readers may refer to *Historical Statistics of Hawaii*, specifically Sections 1 and 3 for population, Section 2 for vital statistics, and Section 15 for housing.

B. Labor Force and Jobs

This section provides statistics on Hawaii's civilian labor force, including counts for the employed and unemployed, the unemployed rates, and wage and salary jobs categorized by industry.

The primary sources for these statistics are the annual tabulations from the Hawaii State Department of Business, Economic Development & Tourism (DBEDT). Agricultural employment data are sourced from the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) National Agricultural Statistics Service (NASS) and its Hawaii Field Office.

Estimation of agriculture jobs and total jobs (as the sum of non-agriculture and agriculture jobs) was discontinued by the Hawaii Department of Labor & Industrial Relations (DLIR) after 2011 when the Hawaii Department of Agriculture (DoA) discontinued its field survey. Since then, only state estimates are available from the U.S. Department of Agriculture's (USDA), National Agricultural Statistics Service (NASS)'s Quick Stats online database.

For those conducting longitudinal research or seeking data from earlier years, historical figures and long-term trends are available in Section 4 of *Historical Statistics of Hawaii*.

C. Gross Domestic Product, Income and Tax

This section presents statistics on total and per capita gross domestic products (GDP) and personal income. GDP figures are reported in both current and constant (inflation-adjusted) dollars. Personal income data includes total figures as well as specific components of state and county-level income. Additionally, this section provides data on the major tax revenues and tax bases of the

The primary data source for these tables are the U.S. Bureau of Economic Analysis (BEA), the U.S. Census Bureau, and the Hawaii State Department of Taxation (DoTax). Per capita estimates presented in this section are calculated by DBEDT using the U.S. Census Bureau's annual population estimates. Note that the Department of Taxation's compilation of county data on a "location of payer" basis was discontinued after 2017.

Due to the Federal Shutdown, many of the federally-sourced data releases were delayed and rescheduled or cancelled. BEA's "Gross Domestic Product by County and Personal Income by County, 2024" originally scheduled for release on December 3, 2025, have been rescheduled for release on February 5, 2026. Tables C-1 to C-12 will be updated when data become available. BEA state data updated September 26th but due to revisions for earlier years was no longer comparable to the county data. See the *Quarterly Statistical & Economic Report* (QSER) 2025Q4, tables B-01 to B-13 for updated state data.

E. Construction

This section contains tables reporting the value of building permits issued, including total figures and breakdowns by the types of construction activity: residential, commercial, and additions and alterations. The data are sourced from the counties' building permit offices and the U.S. Census Bureau.

Kauai County discontinued the public release of building permit data in 2001. Therefore, data for that county are sourced from the U.S. Census Bureau's building permit survey, and only residential data are available for this county.

F. Business and Production

This section presents tables regarding business establishments and the number of private employers, including totals and a specific breakdown of firms with fewer than 50 employees. Additionally, this section provides data on farm earnings and cash receipts from the marketings of crops and livestock.

Primary sources for these statistics include the Hawaii State Department of Business, Economic Development & Tourism (DBEDT), and the U.S. Census Bureau’s County Business Patterns. While the U.S. Bureau of Economic Analysis (BEA) has historically provided agricultural data as part of its personal income series, the bureau discontinued the compilation and release of cash receipts from marketing data on September 27, 2024 for the state and on November 14, 2024 for the counties; farm earnings data remain unaffected by this change.

Due to the recent federal shutdown, many of the federally sourced data releases were delayed. BEA’s “Gross Domestic Product by County and Personal Income by County, 2024” originally scheduled for release on December 3, 2025, have been rescheduled to February 5, 2026. Table F-7 will be updated once these data become available.

For earlier historical periods, agricultural data are summarized in Section 13 of *Historical Statistics of Hawaii*, while business information is provided in Sections 22, and 23.

G. Utilities

Additional information is sourced from monthly financial reports issued by the state's utility providers: Hawaiian Electric Company, Maui Electric Company, Hawaii Electric Light Company, and the Kauai Island Utility Cooperative.

H. Other

This section contains tables regarding voter activity, healthcare capacity, social assistance programs, transportation metrics, and public safety statistics for the State of Hawaii and its four counties.

Data regarding registered voters and votes cast are sourced from the official election results published by the Hawaii State Office of Elections. Statistics on hospital bed capacity are provided by the Hawaii State Department of Health (DOH). Information on government assistance programs for individuals and families in need is derived from reports and records maintained by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services and the Hawaii State Department of Human Services. For historical data in these areas, readers should consult *Historical Statistics of Hawaii*: Section 24 for elections, Section 2 for hospital beds, and Section 8 for government assistance programs.

Additionally, this section presents tables on motor vehicle registrations and crime statistics. Vehicle registration data are compiled by the Hawaii State Department of Transportation’s Highways Division and the Hawaii Automobile Dealers Association. Corresponding historical figures through 1976 are available in Section 17 of *Historical Statistics of Hawaii*. Crime statistics, specifically index offenses known to the police, are based on summary reports issued by the Hawaii State Department of the Attorney General, which are compiled from data submitted by the respective county police departments.

Figures on crime in earlier years appear in *Historical Statistics of Hawaii*, Section 10.
