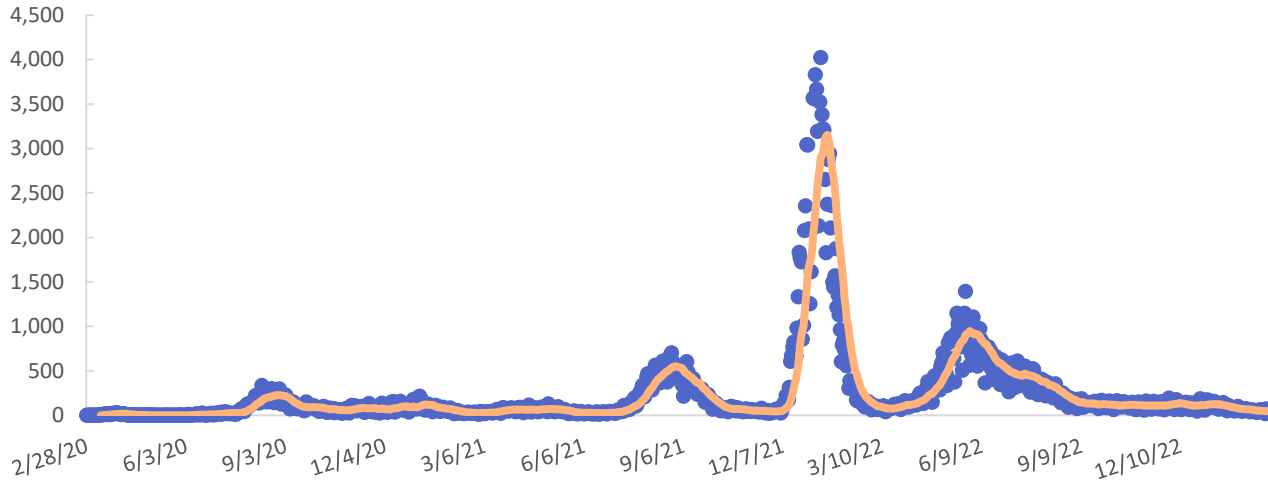

New known cases and 14-day moving average



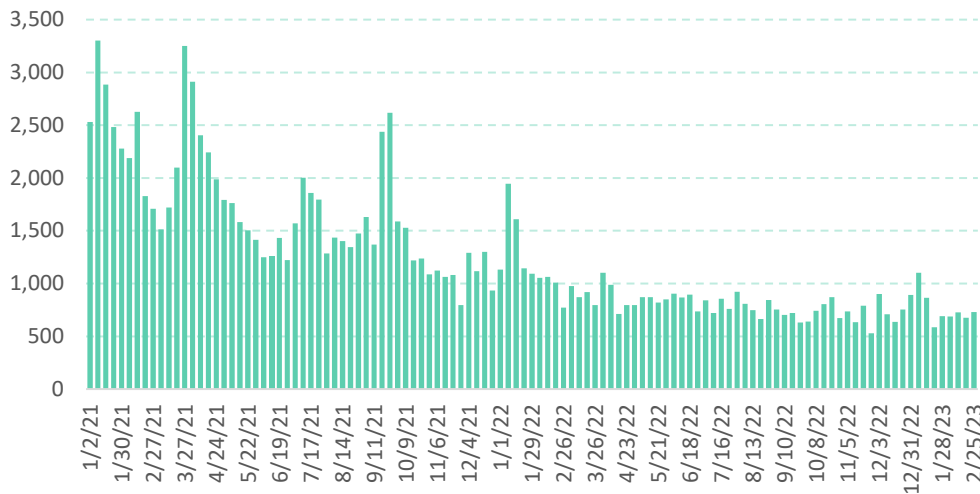

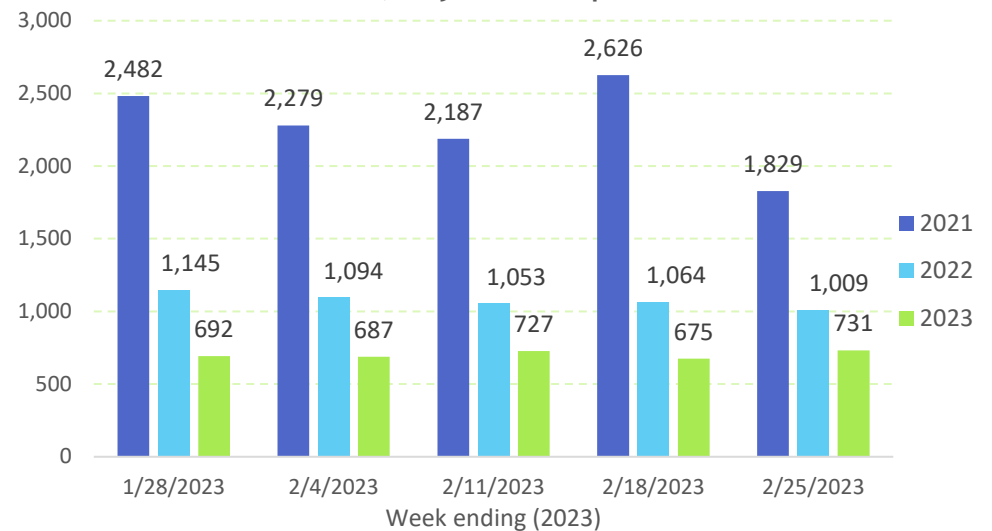

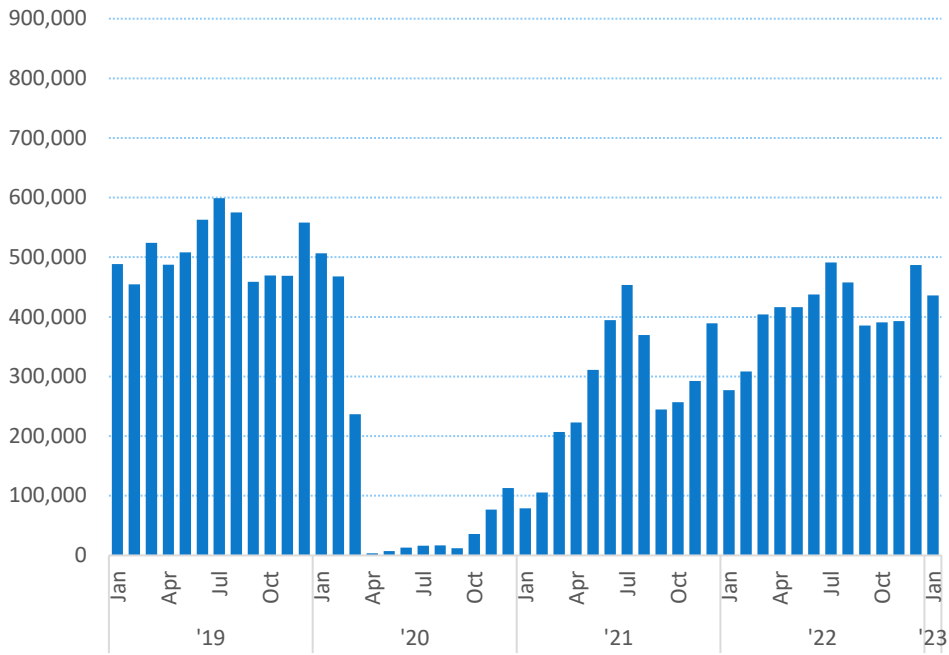

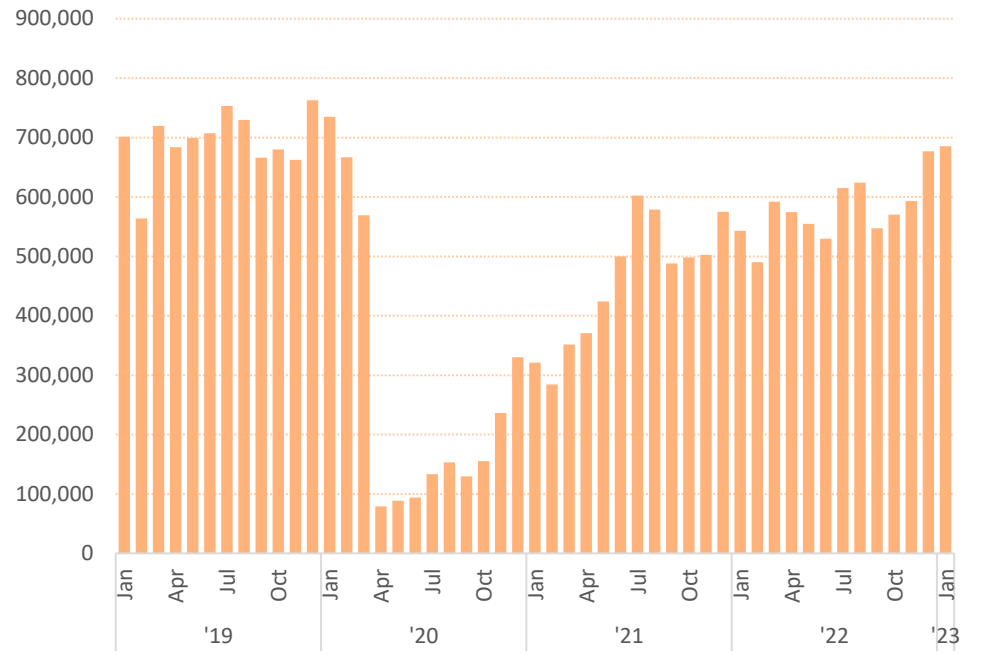

Total visitor arrivals by air

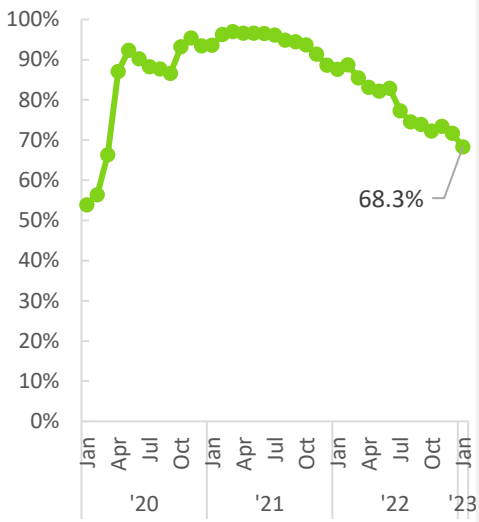


Total airseats

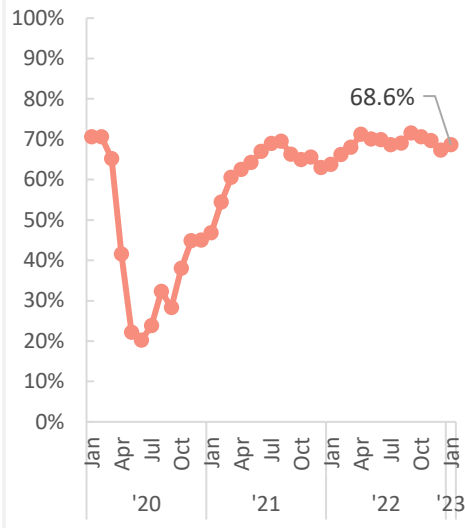

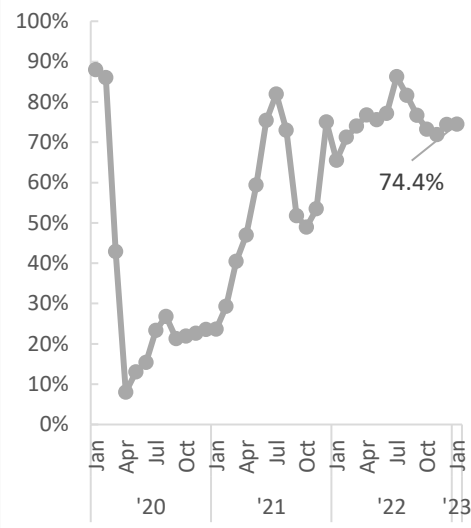
US mainland visitors (% of total arrivals)



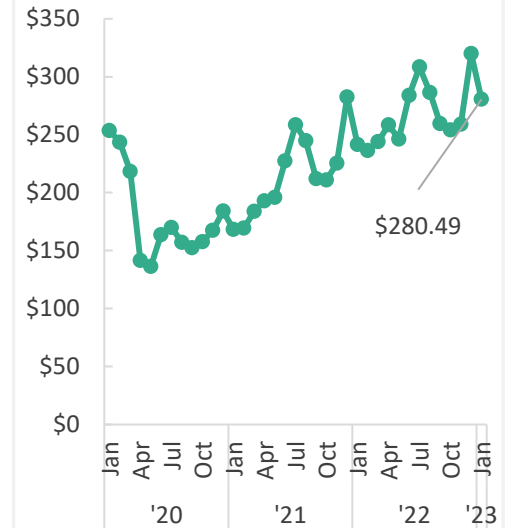
Visitors staying in hotels (%)

Average hotel room rate (\$)

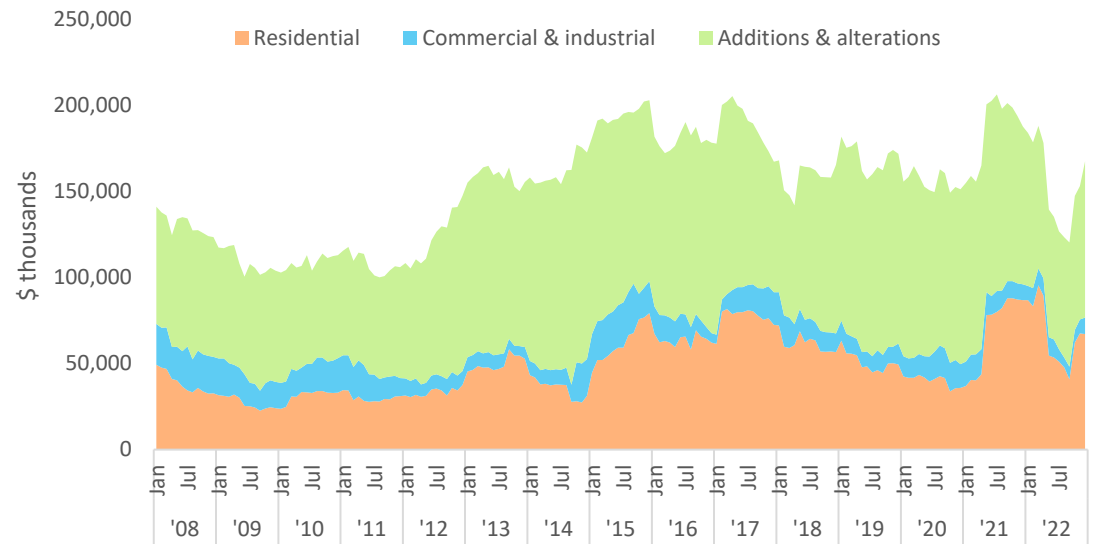

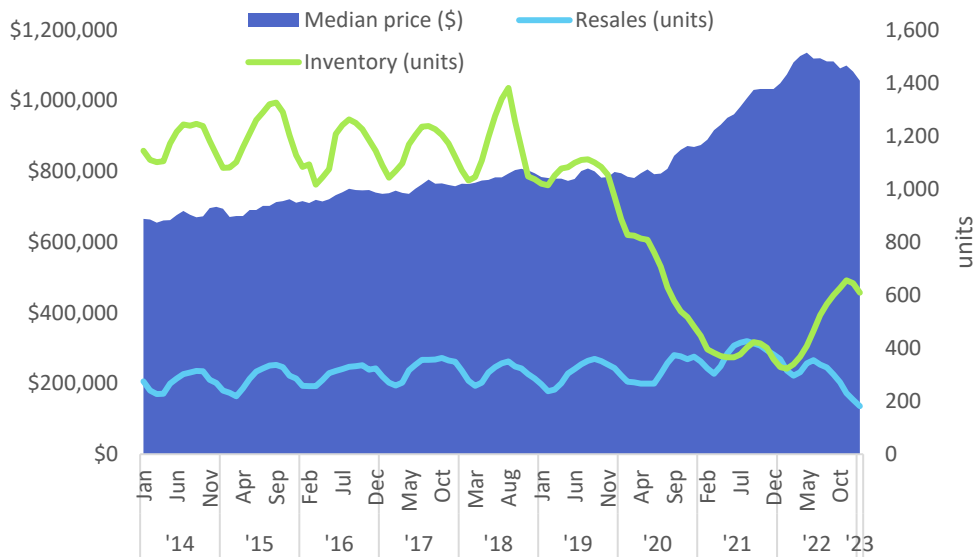
Private building permits (values in \$ thousands)*



*12 month moving average

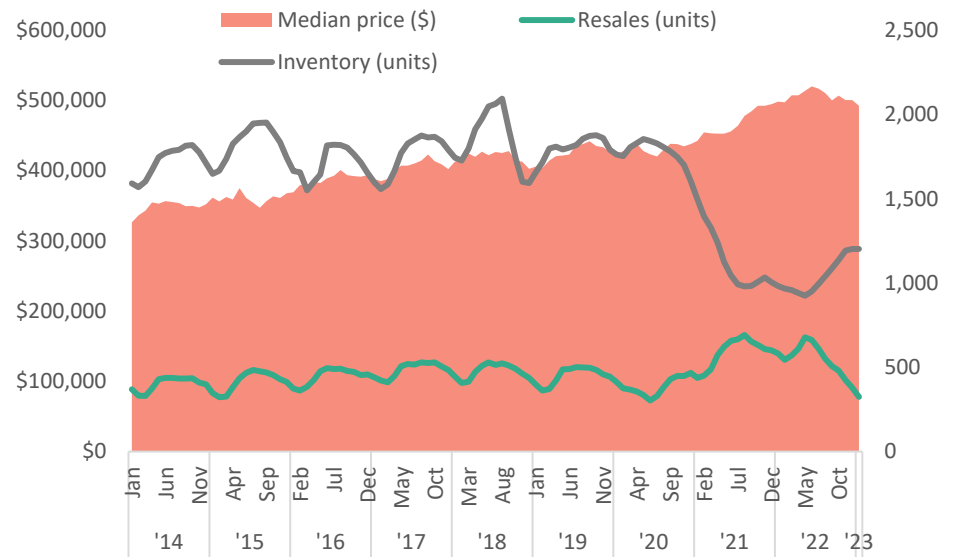
Housing Market
