



Economic Impact of the Armed Forces in Hawaii

Expenditures & Appropriations

Fiscal Year 2005

- Total defense expenditures in Hawaii were \$5.6 billion, an increase of 8.7% over FY 2004.
 - ❖ Defense procurement contracts in Hawaii totaled nearly \$2.0 billion, an increase of 16.2% over FY 2004.

Fiscal Year 2006

- Appropriations for FY 2006 defense projects totaled \$ 767 million.
 - This includes a military construction program of \$354 million, and \$413 million for defense-related projects.


Fiscal Year 2007

- > Appropriations for FY 2007 defense projects total nearly \$622 million.
 - This includes a military construction program of \$208 million, and \$372 million for defense-related projects and three other defense-related programs.

Housing Initiatives

Ongoing programs to privatize construction, renovation and operation of military housing will total an estimated \$3.0 billion over the next 10 years.


