# Executive Summary 3rd Quarter 2025

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This *Quarterly Statistical and Economic Report* has been prepared by Mary Blewitt, Rene Kamita, and Paul Oshiro with assistance from other staff of the Research and Economic Analysis Division of the State Department of Business, Economic Development & Tourism (DBEDT). The report provides concise statistical information and analyses on Labor, Income and Prices, Taxes, Tourism, Construction, and other indicators, as well as an overview of the State of Hawai'i and the four counties.

Technical notes and source descriptions have been kept to a minimum. However, the staff of the Research and Economic Analysis Division would be happy to respond to any inquiries of a technical nature that readers may have (586-2466). The quarterly information contained in this report reflects data received by the Research Division on or before September 4, 2025.

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#### STATE OF THE ECONOMY

Hawai'i's major economic indicators were largely positive in the second quarter of 2025. The civilian labor force, wage and salary jobs, visitor arrivals, government contracts awarded, and private building permit authorizations increased. However, State general fund tax revenues decreased due to reduced income tax revenues.

In the second quarter of 2025, the total number of visitors arriving by air to Hawai'i increased 57,315 or 2.4 percent and the average daily visitor census increased 4,352 or 1.9 percent from the same quarter of 2024.

In the second quarter of 2025, the construction sector added 1,200 jobs or 3.1 percent compared with the same quarter of 2024, while the permit value for private construction increased \$308.4 million or 24.7 percent. Government contracts awarded in the second quarter of 2025 increased \$281.4 million or 62.0 percent compared to the same quarter of 2024. According to the most recent data available, the contracting tax base increased 18.7 percent or \$594.2 million in the first quarter of 2025, compared to the same quarter of the previous year.

In the second quarter of 2025, State general fund tax revenues decreased \$38.1 million or 1.4 percent over the same period of 2024. The state general excise tax revenue increased \$83.8 million or 7.5 percent, the transient accommodations tax (TAT) increased \$2.2 million or 1.1 percent, the net corporate income tax revenues decreased \$31.1 million or 12.4 percent, and the net individual income tax revenues decreased \$85.4 million or 7.8 percent. In the first half of 2025, State general fund tax revenues decreased \$150.8 million or 3.0 percent compared to same period of the previous year.

Labor market conditions were positive. In the second quarter of 2025, the civilian labor force increased 8,950 or 1.3 percent from the same quarter of 2024. Civilian employment increased 9,350 or 1.4 percent. The unemployment rate (not seasonally adjusted) was 2.8 percent in the second quarter of 2025, a decrease of 0.1 percentage point from the second quarter of 2024. Nonagricultural wage and salary jobs increased by 14,800 jobs or 2.3 percent from the second quarter of 2024.

The job increase in the second quarter of 2025 was due to job increases in both the government and private sectors. The private sector added about 13,400 non-agricultural jobs compared to second quarter of 2024. Most private sector industries added jobs in the quarter. The number of jobs increased the most in Health Care and Social Assistance, which gained 3,500 jobs or 4.6 percent; followed by Food Services and

Drinking Places, which added 3,400 jobs or 5.1 percent; Accommodations, which gained 1,300 jobs or 3.3 percent; Construction, which gained 1,200 jobs or 3.1 percent; and Arts, Entertainment, and Recreation, which added 1,100 jobs or 8.1 percent in the quarter. The Government sector gained 1,400 jobs or 1.1 percent in the second quarter of 2025 compared to the same quarter of 2024. The Federal Government lost 1,200 jobs or 3.4 percent, the State Government added 2,200 jobs or 3.0 percent, and the Local Government added 400 jobs or 2.1 percent, compared to the second quarter of 2024.

In the first quarter of 2025, total annualized nominal GDP increased \$5,199 million or 4.6 percent, from the same quarter of 2024. In 2024, total annualized nominal GDP increased \$5,362 million or 4.9 percent from the previous year. In the first quarter of 2025, total annualized real GDP (in chained 2017 dollars) increased \$1,313 million or 1.5 percent from the same quarter of 2024. In 2024, total annualized real GDP increased \$1,666 million or 1.9 percent from the previous year.

In the first quarter of 2025, total non-farm private sector annualized earnings increased \$2,443.7 million or 4.9 percent from the same quarter of 2024. In dollar terms, the largest increase occurred in Health Care and Social Assistance; followed by Transportation and Warehousing, and Construction. During the first quarter of 2025, total government earnings increased \$773.0 million or 4.1 percent from the same quarter of 2024. Earnings from the federal government increased \$330.9 million. Earnings from the state and local governments increased \$442.1 million in the quarter.

In the first half of 2025, Honolulu's Consumer Price Index for Urban Consumers (CPI-U) increased 2.9 percent from the same period in 2024. This is 0.3 percentage points above the 2.6 percent increase for the U.S. average CPI-U in the first half of 2025. It is lower than the 4.7 percent increase in the Honolulu CPI-U for the first half of 2024 compared to the same period of 2023. In the first half of 2025, the Honolulu CPI-U increased the most in Food and Beverages (4.6 percent), followed by Transportation (4.0 percent), Apparel (3.8 percent), Other Goods and Services (3.0 percent), Housing (2.6 percent), Medical Care (2.5 percent), and Recreation (2.2 percent). The Honolulu CPI-U decreased in Education and Communication (1.2 percent) compared to the first half of 2024.

#### **OUTLOOK FOR THE ECONOMY**

Hawai'i's economy strengthened in the first quarter of 2025 compared with the same quarter in 2024. Overall economic activity is now 1.8 percent above pre-pandemic levels recorded in late 2019. Several tourism-related industries (accommodation, food services, transportation, and recreation) remain below pre-pandemic levels. Non-tourism industries such as professional services, health care, and information have helped offset the uneven rebound in visitor-related industries.

After growing in the first half of 2025, the visitor industry faces mid-year challenges. In the first half of 2025, visitor arrivals by air and cruise ship increased 2.3 percent, or 109,650 compared to the same period in 2024. Visitor spending by air and cruise ship rose to \$11.0 billion, up 6.5 percent. However, July visitor arrivals and spending declined compared to July 2024.

The construction industry continued to expand through July 2025. The average construction payroll job count was 40,000 during the first seven months of 2025, a 2.8 percent increase compared to the same period last year. The value of private building permits increased 33.4 percent during the first seven months of 2025. Government contracts increased 31.2 percent in the first half of the year. State government capital improvement project (CIP) expenditures, however, declined by 11.2 percent over the same period.

Based on the most recent data from the U.S. Bureau of Economic Analysis, Hawai'i's real gross domestic product (GDP) grew 1.5 percent in the first quarter of 2025 compared to the first quarter of 2024. Personal income grew by 4.4 percent in the first quarter of 2025 compared to the first quarter of 2024.

Hawai'i's labor market continued to be strong through July 2025, building on steady gains in recent quarters. The civilian labor force and employment both expanded, while unemployment and the jobless rate declined. Non-agricultural wage and salary jobs rose by 2.1 percent in the first seven months of 2025 compared to the same period in 2024. Recent federal job losses have been offset by private sector and state and local government job gains. In July, the State had the third lowest unemployment rate (not seasonally adjusted) in the nation, tied with North Dakota.

State general excise tax collections increased by 5.9 percent in the half of 2025 (latest data available) compared to the same period a year ago.

Inflation, as measured by the Honolulu Consumer Price Index for Urban Consumers (CPI-U), has decreased from 4.1 percent in January 2025 to 2.3 percent in July. DBEDT expects inflationary pressures to intensify in the second half of 2025 and into early 2026 as the effects of heightened tariffs make their way through the economy, before easing in 2027.

At the national level, the most recent (August 2025) Blue Chip Economic Indicators report, the consensus of 50 economic forecasting organizations, projected the U.S. economy to grow at 1.6 percent in 2025, and 1.5 percent in 2026. DBEDT estimates that Hawai'i's real GDP will increase by 1.3 percent in 2025, 1.4 percent in 2026, 1.6 percent in 2027, and 1.8 percent in 2028.

Visitor arrivals are projected to remain stable in 2025 and will improve starting in 2026. Visitor spending is projected to be \$21.2 billion in 2025 and is expected to increase to \$23.0 billion by 2028.

Non-agriculture payroll job growth is expected to increase by 1.4 percent in 2025 and then by 0.9 percent each year between 2025 and 2028. A full recovery of non-agriculture payroll jobs is expected to occur in 2027 when the total will reach 659,700 jobs.

The state unemployment rate is expected to be 2.9 percent in 2025 and 2026 and will improve to 2.8 percent in 2027 and 2.7 percent 2028.

Personal income is expected to grow at 4.5 percent in 2025, 4.4 percent in 2026, and 4.3 percent per year in 2026 and 2027.

As measured by the Honolulu Consumer Price Index for Urban Consumers, inflation is expected to be at 3.0 percent in 2025, which is higher than the projected U.S. consumer inflation rate of 2.8 percent for the same year. Hawai'i consumer inflation is expected to decrease to 2.2 percent by 2028.

Hawai'i's population is expected to increase by 0.1 percent each year between 2025 and 2028.

#### COUNTY ECONOMIC CONDITIONS

Maui County continued to recover from the impacts of the August 8, 2023 wildfires in the second quarter of 2025 compared to the second quarter of 2024. Maui County unemployment decreased while its visitor arrivals and value of building permits increased. All counties added jobs. Honolulu saw a slight increase in visitor arrivals, an increase in the value of private building permits, and no change in unemployment rate compared to the same quarter in 2024. Kaua'i saw lower unemployment, an increase in visitor arrivals, and an increase in the value of building permits (residential only). Hawai'i County saw a slightly higher unemployment rate, a decrease in visitor arrivals, and a decrease in the value of private building permits.

In the second quarter of 2025, the unemployment rate remained the same at 2.6 percent in Honolulu; decreased 0.1 of a percentage point from 2.6 percent to 2.5 percent in Kaua'i; and increased 0.1 of a percentage point from 3.1 percent to 3.2 percent in Hawai'i County. Maui County's unemployment rate decreased 1.2 percentage points from 4.3 percent to 3.1 percent.

In the second quarter of 2025, Honolulu added 11,300 or 2.5 percent non-agricultural wage and salary jobs compared to the same quarter of 2024. The number of jobs increased the most in Health Care and Social Assistance, which added 3,000 jobs or 5.3 percent; followed by Food Services & Drinking Places, which added 2,100 jobs or 4.6 percent; and Construction, which added 1,200 jobs or 4.3 percent. The Government sector added 700 jobs or 0.7 percent, with the Federal government losing 1,100 jobs or 3.4 percent while the State government gained 1,600 jobs or 3.0 percent and the Local government gained 200 jobs or 1.7 percent.

In the second quarter of 2025, Hawai'i County added 1,100 or 1.5 percent of non-agricultural wage and salary jobs over the same quarter of 2024. The number of jobs increased the most in Health Care and Social Assistance, which added 200 jobs or 2.5 percent. Wholesale Trade; Professional & Business Services; Arts,

Entertainment & Recreation; Food Services & Drinking Places; and Other Services added 100 jobs each. The Government sector added 500 jobs or 3.3 percent.

Maui County gained 1,800 or 2.5 percent of non-agricultural wage and salary jobs in the second quarter of 2025 over the same quarter of 2024. The largest increase in the number of jobs was in Food Services & Drinking Places, which gained 700 jobs or 8.0 percent; followed by Accommodation, which added 500 jobs or 4.7 percent; and Health Care & Social Assistance, which added 300 jobs or 3.7 percent. The Government sector added 100 jobs or 1.1 percent.

Kaua'i gained 800 non-agricultural wage and salary jobs or 2.5 percent in the second quarter of 2025 compared to the same quarter of 2024. The number of jobs increased the most in Food Services & Drinking Places, which added 400 jobs or 9.3 percent, followed by Professional & Business Services and Other Services, each of which added 200 jobs. The Government sector added 100 jobs or 2.0 percent in the quarter.

In the second quarter of 2025, visitor arrivals by air increased in Honolulu, Kauaʻi, and Maui County but decreased in Hawaiʻi County. Visitor arrivals by air increased 0.7 percent in Honolulu, increased 9.2 percent in Maui County, and increased 1.3 percent in Kauaʻi. Visitor arrivals decreased 1.5 percent in Hawaiʻi County compared to the same quarter of 2024.

In the second quarter of 2025, the value of private building permits increased in Honolulu, Maui County, and Kaua'i (only residential available) but decreased in Hawai'i County. In the second quarter of 2025, private building permits increased \$366.1 million or 46.7 percent in Honolulu, increased \$21.8 million or 15.5 percent in Maui County, and increased \$8.8 million or 39.6 percent in Kaua'i (only residential available). Private building permits decreased \$88.4 million or 29.4 percent in Hawai'i County from the same quarter of the previous year.

#### A. LABOR FORCE AND JOBS

Hawai'i's labor market conditions were positive in the second quarter of 2025 compared to the same quarter of 2024. The civilian labor force and civilian employment increased. Civilian unemployment and the unemployment rate decreased. Civilian non-agricultural wage and salary jobs increased in both the private and government sectors compared to the first quarter of 2024.

In the second quarter of 2025, the civilian labor force averaged 687,600 people, an increase of 8,950 people or 1.3 percent from the same quarter of 2024 (Table A-1). In the first half of 2025, the civilian labor force increased 10,150 people or 1.5 percent from the same period of the previous year.

Civilian employment averaged 668,500 people in the second quarter of 2025, an increase of 9,350 people or 1.4 percent compared to the same quarter of 2024 (Table A-2). In the first half of 2025, average civilian employment increased 10,700 people or 1.6 percent from the same period of the previous year.

In the second quarter of 2025, the number of civilian unemployed averaged 19,100, a decrease of 350 people or 1.8 percent from the same quarter of 2024 (Table A-3). In the first half of 2025, the number of unemployed decreased 550 people or 2.9 percent from the same period of the previous year.

The unemployment rate (not seasonally adjusted) was 2.8 percent in the second quarter of 2025, a decrease of 0.1 percentage point from the second quarter of 2024 (Table A-4). In the first

half of 2025, the unemployment rate decreased 0.1 percentage points from 2.8 percent in the first half of 2024 to 2.7 percent.

In the second quarter of 2025, Hawai'i's non-agricultural wage and salary jobs averaged 652,200 jobs, an increase of 14,800 jobs or 2.3 percent from the same quarter of 2024 (Table A-6). In the first half of 2025, average non-agricultural wage and salary jobs increased 2.1 percent or 13,200 jobs from the same period of the previous year.

The increase in jobs in the second quarter of 2025 was due to job increases in both the government and private sectors. The private sector added about 13,400 non-agricultural jobs compared to second quarter of 2024. Most private sector industries added jobs in the quarter. The number of jobs increased the most in Health Care and Social Assistance, which gained 3,500 jobs or 4.6 percent (Table A-16); followed by Food Services and Drinking Places, which added 3,400 jobs or 5.1 percent (Table A-19); Accommodations, which gained 1,300 jobs or 3.3 percent (Table A-18); Construction, which gained 1,200 jobs or 3.1 percent (Table A-7); and Arts, Entertainment, and Recreation, which added 1,100 jobs or 8.1 percent in the quarter (Table A-17).

The Government sector gained 1,400 jobs or 1.1 percent (Table A-21) in the second quarter of 2025 compared to the same quarter of 2024. The Federal Government lost 1,200 jobs or 3.4 percent (Table A-22), the State Government added 2,200 jobs or 3.0 percent (Table A-23), and the Local Government added 400 jobs or 2.1 percent (Table A-24), compared to the second quarter of 2024.

#### **B. INCOME AND PRICES**

In the first quarter of 2025, total annualized nominal GDP increased \$5,199 million or 4.6 percent, from the same quarter of 2024. In 2024, total annualized nominal GDP increased \$5,362 million or 4.9 percent from the previous year. In the first quarter of 2025, total annualized real GDP (in chained 2017 dollars) increased \$1,313 million or 1.5 percent from the same quarter of 2024. In 2024, total annualized real GDP increased \$1,666 million or 1.9 percent from the previous year (Tables B-1 to B-3).

Hawai'i's total personal income increased during the first quarter of 2025, over the same quarter of 2024; all components of personal income increased over the same quarter of the previous year.

In the first quarter of 2025, total nominal annualized personal income (i.e. not adjusted for inflation) increased \$4,360.7 million or 4.4 percent over that of 2024 (Table B-5). In 2024, average personal income was \$100,244.5 million, an increase of \$5,273.7 million or 5.6 percent from the previous year. In the first quarter of 2025, personal income per capita was \$71,247, a 4.3 percent increase over the same quarter of the previous year (Table B-6).

In the first quarter of 2025, wages and salaries increased \$2,211.1 million or 4.6 percent over the same quarter of 2024. In 2024, wages and salaries increased \$2,832.9 million or 6.2 percent from the previous year (Table B-8).

Supplements to wages and salaries, consisting of employer payments to retirement plans, private group health insurance plans, private workers compensation plans, and other such benefits, increased \$751.0 million or 5.5 percent in the first quarter of 2025 from the same quarter of 2024 (Table B-9). In 2024, supplements to wages and salaries increased \$934.5 million or 7.1 percent from the previous year.

Proprietors' income increased \$254.0 million or 3.3 percent in the first quarter of 2025 over that of 2024 (Table B-10). In 2024, proprietors' income was up \$408.1 million or 5.6 percent from the previous year.

Dividends, interest, and rent increased \$443.4 million or 2.2 percent in the first quarter of 2025 from the same quarter of 2024. In 2024, income in this category was up \$649.4 million or 3.3 percent from the previous year (Table B-11).

The annualized personal current transfer receipts increased \$1,066.5 million or 5.9 percent in the first quarter of 2025 from the same quarter of 2024 (Table B-12). In 2024, personal current transfer receipts increased \$858.2 million or 4.9 percent from the previous year.

Contributions to government social insurance (which is subtracted from total personal income) increased \$365.3 million or 4.4 percent in the first quarter of 2025 compared to the same quarter of 2024. In 2024, these contributions increased \$409.4 million or 5.1 percent from the previous year (Table B-13).

In the first quarter of 2025, total non-farm private sector annualized earnings increased \$2,443.7 million or 4.9 percent from the same quarter of 2024 (Table B-4). In dollar terms, the largest increase occurred in health care and social assistance; followed by transportation and warehousing, and construction. During the first quarter of 2025, total government earnings increased \$773.0 million or 4.1 percent from the same quarter of 2024. Earnings from the federal government increased \$330.9 million. Earnings from the state and local governments increased \$442.1 million in the quarter.

In the first half of 2025, Honolulu's Consumer Price Index for Urban Consumers (CPI-U) increased 2.9 percent from the same period in 2024 (Table B-14). This is 0.3 percentage points above the 2.6 percent increase for the U.S. average CPI-U in the first half of 2025. It is lower than the 4.7 percent increase in the Honolulu CPI-U for the first half of 2024 compared to the same period of the previous year. In the first half of 2025, the Honolulu CPI-U increased the most in Food and Beverages (4.6 percent), followed by Transportation (4.0 percent), Apparel (3.8 percent), Other Goods and Services (3.0 percent), Housing (2.6 percent), Medical Care (2.5 percent), and Recreation (2.2 percent). The Honolulu CPI-U decreased in Education and Communication (1.2 percent) compared to the first half of 2024.

#### C. TAX REVENUES

The State general fund tax revenues decreased in the second quarter of 2025 compared to the same quarter of 2024. Among the components shown, the Net Individual Income Tax and the Net Corporate Income Tax revenues decreased while General Excise and Use Tax (GET) and Transient Accommodations Tax (TAT) collections increased.

In the second quarter of 2025, total tax collections distributed to the State general fund totaled \$2,774.4 million, a decrease of \$38.1 million or 1.4 percent over the same quarter of 2024 (Tables C-1 and C-2). In the first half of 2025, State general fund tax revenues decreased \$150.8 million or 3.0 percent over the same period in the previous year.

During the second quarter of 2025, GET revenues (excluding the Counties' Surcharges) totaled \$1,199.4 million, an increase of \$83.8 million or 7.5 percent over the same quarter of 2024 (Table C-3). In the first half of 2025, GET revenues increased \$135.4 million or 5.9 percent from the first half of the previous year.

Compared to the second quarter of 2024, Net Individual Income Tax revenues decreased \$85.4 million or 7.8 percent to \$1,015.4 million in the second quarter of 2025 (Table C-4). In the second quarter of 2025, Declaration of Estimated Taxes decreased \$39.1 million or 7.9 percent (Table C-5), Payments with Returns increased \$38.0 million or 17.8 percent (Table C-6), Revenues from Withholding Tax on Wages decreased \$95.4 million or 13.7 percent (Table C-7), and Refunds decreased \$11.1 million or 3.7 percent (Table C-8). In the first half of 2025, Net Individual Income Tax collections decreased 155.6 million or 8.9 percent from the same period in 2024.

Net Corporate Income Tax revenues, which tend to be volatile by nature, decreased from \$251.0 million in the second quarter of 2024 to \$219.9 million in the second quarter of 2025, a decrease of \$31.1 million (Table C-9). In the second quarter of 2025, the Declaration of Estimated Taxes decreased \$33.8 million or 13.6 percent (Table C-10), the Payment with Returns decreased \$16.0 million or 45.0 percent (Table C-11), and the Refunds decreased \$18.7 million or 58.1 percent (Table C-12), compared with the same quarter of 2024. In the first half of 2025, Net Corporate Income Tax revenues decreased \$136.5 million or 41.8 percent from the same period in the previous year.

In the second quarter of 2025, TAT revenues increased \$2.2 million, or 1.1 percent compared to the same quarter of 2024 (Table C-13). In the first half of 2025, TAT revenues increased \$4.1 million or 1.0 percent from the same period in the previous year.

According to the most recent data available, in the first quarter of 2025, the Retailing tax base increased 3.2 percent or \$385.1 million (Table C-14), the Services tax base increased 5.5 percent or \$296.9 million (Table C-15), the Contracting tax base increased 18.7 percent or \$594.2 million (Table C-16), and the Hotel Rentals tax base decreased 0.6 percent or \$13.4 million (Table C-17), compared to the same quarter of the previous year. For 2024, the Retailing tax base increased 0.7 percent, the Services tax base increased 5.8 percent, the Contracting tax base increased 17.8 percent, and the Hotel Rentals tax base decreased 4.2 percent.

#### **D. TOURISM**

Both domestic and international visitor arrivals increased in the second quarter of 2025. The domestic average daily census and international average daily census decreased. Nominal visitor expenditures increased compared to the same quarter of 2024.

The total number of visitor arrivals by air increased 57,315 or 2.4 percent in the second quarter of 2025, compared to the second quarter of 2024 (Table D-2). The total average daily census increased by 4,352 or 1.9 percent in the quarter. In the first half of 2025, total visitor arrivals by air increased 114,590 or 2.4 percent, while the average daily census increased 5,497 or 2.4 percent from the previous year.

In the second quarter of 2025, total visitor arrivals on domestic flights increased 55,664 or 2.7 percent compared to the same quarter of 2024 (Table D-3). In the first half of 2025, domestic arrivals were up 135,006 or 3.5 percent from the previous year.

Arrivals on international flights increased 1,651 or 0.5 percent in the second quarter of 2025 compared to the second quarter of 2024 (Table D-4). In the first half of 2025, international arrivals decreased 20,416 or 2.5 percent from the previous year.

In terms of major market areas, from the second quarter of 2025 to the same period of 2024, arrivals from the U.S. West increased 63,262 or 4.9 percent (Table D-5), arrivals from the U.S. East decreased 8,421 or 1.4 percent (Table D-6), and arrivals from Japan increased 6,033 or 4.0 percent (Table D-7). In the first half of 2025, arrivals from the U.S. West were up 104,764 or 4.3 percent; arrivals from the U.S. East were up 27,148 or 2.2 percent; and Japanese arrivals were up 1,334 or 0.4 percent from the previous year.

The total average daily visitor census was up 1.9 percent or 4,352 visitors per day in the second quarter of 2025, over the same quarter of 2024 (Table D-8). The domestic average daily census increased 1.5

percent or 2,847 visitors per day (Table D-9) and the international average daily census increased 4.9 percent or 1,504 visitors per day (Table D-10). In the first half of 2025, the domestic average daily census increased 5,204 or 2.7 percent; and the international average daily census increased by 293 or 0.8 percent from the previous year.

Nominal visitor expenditures by air totaled \$5,324.1 million in the second quarter of 2025, an increase of \$226.5 million or 4.4 percent from the second quarter of 2024 (Table D-11). In the first half of 2025, visitor expenditures totaled \$10,913.0 million, an increase of \$668.0 million or 6.5 percent from the same period of the previous year.

Total airline capacity, as measured by the number of available seats flown to Hawai'i, decreased 2.8 percent or by 92,113 seats (Table D-12) in the second quarter of 2025, domestic seats decreased 2.8 percent or 75,968 seats (Table D-13), and international seats decreased 2.6 percent or 16,145 seats (Table D-14), compared to the same quarter of 2024. In the first half of 2025, the number of total available seats decreased 1.6 percent or 105,068 seats, domestic seats decreased 0.02 percent or 811 seats, and international seats decreased 7.6 percent or 105,879 seats from the same period of the previous year.

In the second quarter of 2025, the statewide hotel occupancy rate averaged 72.9 percent, the same as in the second quarter of 2024 (Table D-15). In the first half of 2025, the statewide hotel occupancy rate averaged 74.4 percent, 0.3 percentage points below the occupancy rate for the same period of the previous year.



#### E. CONSTRUCTION

Construction jobs and government contracts increased in the second quarter of 2025, however, state government CIP expenditures decreased. Private building authorizations increased for the state overall. Authorizations increased in Honolulu County, Maui County, and Kaua'i County but decreased in Hawai'i County compared to the second quarter of 2024.

In the second quarter of 2025, the number of jobs in the construction sector increased by 3.1 percent or by 1,200 jobs compared with the same quarter of 2024. In the first half of 2025, the construction sector added 1,000 jobs or 2.6 percent (Table A-7) compared to the same period of the previous year.

In the second quarter of 2025, private building authorizations in the state increased \$308.4 million or 24.7 percent, compared with the second quarter of 2024 (Table E-8). In the first half of 2025, private building authorizations in the state increased \$709.8 million or 31.5 percent compared with same period of 2024.

In the second quarter of 2025, private building authorizations in Honolulu County increased \$366.1 million or 46.7 percent, compared with the second quarter of 2024 (Table E-8). In the first half of 2025, private building authorizations in Honolulu County increased \$617.3 million or 44.5 percent, compared with the same period in the previous year.

In the second quarter of 2025, private building authorizations in Hawai'i County decreased \$88.4 million or 29.4 percent, compared with the second quarter of 2024 (Table E-8). In the first half of 2025, private building authorizations in Hawai'i County increased \$9.5 million or 1.9 percent, compared with the same period of the previous year.

In the second quarter of 2025, private building authorizations in Maui County increased \$21.8 million or 15.5 percent, compared with the second quarter of 2024 (Table E-8). In the first half of 2025, private building authorizations in Maui County increased \$85.0 million or 28.8 percent compared with the same period of the previous year.

In the second quarter of 2025, private building authorizations in Kaua'i County (residential only) increased \$8.8 million or 39.6 percent, compared with the second quarter of 2024 (Table E-8). In the first half

of 2025, private building authorizations in Kaua'i County decreased \$2.0 million or 3.0 percent compared with the same period of the previous year.

In the second quarter of 2025, government contracts awarded increased \$281.4 million or 62.0 percent, compared with the second quarter of 2024 (Table E-1). In the first half of 2025, government contracts awarded increased \$259.3 million or 31.2 percent compared with the same period of the previous year.

State government CIP expenditures decreased \$71.3 million or 15.7 percent in the second quarter of 2025 compared with the same quarter of 2024. In the first half of 2025, state government CIP expenditures decreased \$90,957.5 million or 11.2 percent from the same period of the previous year (Table E-2).

The Honolulu Construction Cost Index for Single Family Residence (Table E-6) increased 4.3 percent in the second quarter of 2025 compared to the same quarter of 2024 and similarly increased 4.6 percent for High-Rise Building (Table E-7). In the first half of 2025, the index for Single Family Residence increased 3.9 percent and 3.8 percent for High-Rise Building as compared to the previous year.

Average home prices increased by 4.0 percent in the second quarter of 2025, with single family home prices up by 1.3 percent and condo prices stable over the same quarter of the previous year (Table E-9). The purchase of homes decreased by 8.1 percent for local buyers, by 33.6 percent for mainland buyers, and by 6.8 percent for foreign buyers over the same quarter of the previous year (Table E-10).

In the second quarter of 2025, Honolulu's median price for single family resales was \$1,150,000, up \$50,000 or 4.5 percent over the same quarter of 2024 (Table G-29). The median price for condominium unit resales was \$505,000, down \$5,000 or 1.0 percent over the same quarter of 2024 (Table G-33). In the second quarter of 2025, the number of single-family unit resales decreased 0.5 percent, while the number of condominium unit resales decreased 10.8 percent, compared with the second quarter of 2024 (Tables G-37 and G-41). In the first half of 2025, the number of single-family unit resales decreased 2.1 percent, while condominium unit resales decreased 6.0 percent compared with the same period of the previous year.

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#### F. OTHER INDICATORS

The total number of bankruptcy filings in Hawai'i increased by 2.5 percent or by 7 cases for the second quarter of 2025, from the same quarter of 2024. In the first half of 2025, total filings decreased 3.9 percent or 23 cases from the same period of the previous year.

The number of Chapter 7 filings, the largest category, decreased by 6.3 percent or by 12 cases in the second quarter of 2025. Chapter 7 filings are intended to liquidate assets and discharge debt. In the first half of 2025, Chapter 7 filings decreased 12.4 percent or 47 cases from the same period of the previous year.

Chapter 11 filings remained the same at 1 case in the second quarter of 2025 compared to the second quarter of 2024. In the first half of 2025, Chapter 11 filings increased to 3 cases

from 1 case in the same period of the previous year. Chapter 11 filings involve the structuring of repayment plans for companies.

Chapter 13 filings increased by 20.4 percent or 19 cases in the second quarter of 2025, from the same quarter of 2024. In the first half of 2025, Chapter 13 filings increased 11.0 percent or 23 cases from the same period of the previous year. Chapter 13 bankruptcy allows debtors to work out repayment arrangements with creditors.
