Hawaii is a healthy place to live and work. It is one of the few places in the world free of rabies, malaria, dengue fever, yellow fever, filariasis and cholera. The last case of smallpox was reported in 1913.

The State Health Department is the oldest in the United States and was founded in 1850 by King Kamehameha III. Vital statistics have been kept continuously since that time.

The Department of Health, Research, Statistics and Planning Office, publishes a semi-annual estimate of civilian population for the state, each of the islands, and the cities of Honolulu and Hilo. Estimates of civilian population and dwelling units by census tract are prepared semi-annually for the City-County of Honolulu and Hawaii County. The annual statistical report of the department gives statistical series for all major divisions within the department.

Hospitals and nursing homes in the state are licensed by the Hospitals and Medical Facilities Branch of the Department of Health. This branch also issues reports of present and planned medical facilities in accordance with provisions of the Hill-Harris Act. More than half the 33 hospitals in the state are accredited by the American Hospital Association. Several hospitals on Oahu have approved training programs for residents and interns.

Licensing of physicians, dentists and other medical personnel is under the jurisdiction of the Department of Regulatory Agencies, Vocational Licensing Division.
