## SECTION 13

## Elections

This section presents data on the number of registered voters, votes cast, and the party affiliation of elected officials.

More than 274,000 persons were registered to vote in the general election of November 1968. This amounted to 38.2 percent of the civilian population (including those below the legal voting age or otherwise ineligible); the proportion registered was 32.4 percent in 1959 and 21.9 percent in 1940. The minimum voting age is 20 years.

Elective offices in Hawaii include the Presidency, two U.S. Senators, two U.S. Congressmen, the Governor, 25 State Senators, 51 State Representatives, and various County officials.

Official election results are published by the Office of the Lieutenant Governor. Additional information is often available from the various County Clerks and the Legislative Reference Bureau of the University of Hawaii. National statistics appear in the Statistical Abstract of the United States: 1969, Section 13.
