## Section 16 <br> Communications and Power

This section presents statistics relating to postal service, telephone, radio television, newspapers and other periodicals, public utilities, power and energy. Much of this information was obtained from reports and records of the U. S. Post Office Department, Federal Power Commission, Hawaii Public Utilities Commission, Chamber of Commerce of Honolulu, and individual public utilities. Similar data for the nation can be found in sections 18 and 19 of the Statistical Abstract of the United States: 1961.
