SUBJECT: Acceptance of the Final Environmental Impact Statement (FEIS) for the Kaheawa Wind 1 Continued Use Project, Located at Ukumehame in the Wailuku and Lahaina Districts on the island of Maui, further identified as Tax Map Keys: (2) 4-8-001:portion of 001, 3-6-001: portion of 014, and various TMKs associated with the Habitat Conservation Plan Mitigation Sites.

The Board of Land and Natural Resources (Board), at their meeting held on Friday, December 12, 2025, under item D-14, voted unanimously to accept the FEIS for the Kaheawa Wind 1 Continued Use Project. The Board determined that the FEIS satisfactorily fulfilled the requirements pursuant to Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS) Chapter 343 and Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR), Section 11-200.1-28. The procedures for assessment, consultation, review, and the preparation and submission of the FEIS were completed satisfactorily; the content requirements were satisfied, including identifying environmental impacts and adequate mitigation measures as a result of the project; and the FEIS satisfactorily responded to review comments.

Continue operation of the existing KWP 1 wind generation facility for an additional 20.5-year period to provide 30 MW of clean, renewable energy to the island of Maui. The Proposed Action includes a request for a long-term land lease from the State of Hawai'i for an anticipated 25-year lease term to cover the continued operational period, decommissioning and restoration, and contingency. No new construction or physical modifications beyond the proposed maintenance activities are required as part of the Proposed Action.
