The purpose of this letter is to fulfill the request for an "Environ-mental Assessment" as requested in your letter dated December 5, 1989.

Mr. John Ferreira has asked that I act as his agent in this assessmet because of my knowledge through use of the parcel and because I recently acquired perpetual use from the State.

The applicants for the purchase of the subject property are John & Yoko Ferreira. Their objective is to purchase, in fee, the abandoned flume right of way identified as 2-7-06 Par 17 having an area of 0.30 AC.

This parcel is twenty (20) feet wide and divides the Ferreira property, parcel 2-7-06-16 which is zoned ag 10 and is presently being used for pasture land. The terrain is moderate, the vegetation is mostly guava and grass, and there are no archaeological or historical sites. Should the application for purchase be approved the parcel will be consolodated and will continue to be used for agricultural purposes. Because of this there will be no substantial effect on technical, economic, social or environmental charactoristics.
