### 1. Call to order, Roll Call, Introductions, Quorum

With a quorum of 4 members present, Chairperson Sprague called the meeting to order at 1:02 PM.

# 2. Office of Planning and Sustainable Development (OPSD) Director's Update

Director Evans reported that OPSD is waiting for the Governor to approve the bills that were proposed in the Governor's package for the upcoming legislative session. She reported that the bills mostly relate to affordable housing.

Director Evans further reported that Coastal Zone Management (CZM) is working to look at the impact of sea level rise on shoreline parcels and the special management areas. She also reports that they are working to support DBEDT on projects such as a final EIS that was transferred from DLNR to DBEDT.

Director Evans asked the Council to update their rules to comply with Act 152, Session Laws of Hawai'i 2021.

## 4. Exemption Committee Update

Committee Chair Lefebvre reported that the Exemption Committee met with of the State of Hawai'i Department of Education (DOE) to discuss their exemption list. However, there were edits that needed to be made by the DOE, so no action to approve the publication of the list by the Council was needed during this meeting.

Committee Chair Lefebvre reported that there is only one outstanding list by the Department of Hawaiian Homelands (DHHL). DHHL has not presented any new list to the Exemption Committee.

Chairperson Sprague asked Director Evans if there are any task that she would like the Council to get involved in. Director Evans stated that they have received a grant from the US Department of Housing and Urban Development to look at the regulatory requirements for housing permits in Hawai'i. Director Evans asked the Council for guidance on whether there are aspects of HRS 343 and its rules that burden housing and the community.

Vice Chair Hegger-Nordblom asked if there is any framework that the Council could review. Director Evans stated that this project is in the early phases, so she could possibly give the Council the grant application, which would provide the scope of work. When progress is made, work product can be given to the Council for review.

Vice Chair Hegger-Nordblom reported that the Annual Report is being drafted and is working to be finalized. It is looking to be agendized and approved at the next Council meeting in January.

Vice Chair Hegger-Nordblom reported that I&O Committee is looking to hold a forum possibly at the end of February or beginning of March. Final details are still being worked on.

Chairperson Sprague summarized that the Council will tackle the questions pending from OPSD, the Annual Report, and the upcoming forum for the near future. Member Stone also stated that the Council should also start work on the upcoming legislative session and the tracking of bills.
